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Monthly Review of Public Assistance Statistics for July 2008

Ohio Works First (OWF)

For the month of July 2008, OWF-Combined assistance groups totaled 80,296; recipients totaled 173,237 and money payments totaled \$26,853,063. The percent change from June 2008 to July 2008 was 1.3% for assistance groups; 1.7% for recipients, and 1.5% for money payments. For OWF- Regular (OWF-R) there were 76,614 assistance groups; 158,717 recipients, and \$25,254,277 in money payments issued for July 2008. The percent change from June 2008 to July 2008 was 1.2% for assistance groups; 1.5% for recipients, and 1.5% for money payments. For OWF-Unemployed (OWF-U), assistance groups totaled 3,682, recipients, 14,520 and money payments were \$1,598,786. The percent change from June 2008 to July 2008 was 4.4% for assistance groups; 4.0% for recipients and 1.9% for money payments.

Foster Care (TITLE IV-E)

Disability Assistance (DA)

For the month of July 2008, there were 17,847 assistance groups; 17,944 recipients, and \$2,483,483 in DA financial assistance. The average DA financial assistance per recipient was \$138.40. Total DA expenditures for medical services for July 2008 were \$ 1,137,190. Of this total, \$853,642 or 75.1% was spent for prescribed drugs, and \$202,199 or 17.8% was spent for physician services. Medical expenses were paid for 1,974 recipients for an average expenditure of \$576.08 per recipient.

Food And Nutrition Services Benefits (FNS) (Food Stamps)


Total persons participating in the FNS benefits program during July 2008 increased to 1,174,333 by 5,310 or 0.5% from 1,169,023 persons reported in June 2008. Households increased by 2,651 or 0.5% over June 2008 levels. The total dollar value of FNS related benefits issued during July 2008 increased by \$ 1,154,359 or 0.9% from \$124,439,243 reported in June 2008 to \$125,593,602 reported in July 2008. The average benefit issuance per person increased by \$ 0.50 or 0.5% from those issued in June 2008. The average benefit issuance per person increased from \$106.45 reported in June 2008 to \$106.95 reported in July 2008.

Please note: All data in the PAMS report is limited to the information available at the time it was constructed. It does not account for backdated or retroactive eligibility or any adjustments made subsequent to its creation.



No of OWF Combined Net Expenditure During The Last 25 Months





DA Cash Recipients During The Last 25 Months





Food Stamp Benefits Cash Recipients During The Last 25 Months


