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Monthly Review of Public Assistance Statistics for August 2008

Ohio Works First (OWF)

For the month of August 2008, OWF-Combined assistance groups totaled 80,757; recipients totaled 174,664 and money payments totaled \$27,339,612. The percent change from July 2008 to August 2008 was 0.6% for assistance groups; 0.8% for recipients, and 1.8% for money payments. For OWF- Regular (OWF-R) there were 76,990 assistance groups; 159,699 recipients, and \$25,648,236 in money payments issued for August 2008. The percent change from July 2008 to August 2008 was 0.5% for assistance groups; 0.6% for recipients, and 1.6% for money payments. For OWF-Unemployed (OWF-U), assistance groups totaled 3,767, recipients, 14,965 and money payments were \$1,691,376. The percent change from July 2008 to August 2008 was 2.3% for assistance groups; 3.1% for recipients and 5.8% for money payments.

Foster Care (TITLE IV-E)

Disability Assistance (DA)

For the month of August 2008, there were 17,697 assistance groups; 17,787 recipients, and \$2,387,755 in DA financial assistance. The average DA financial assistance per recipient was \$134.24. Total DA expenditures for medical services for August 2008 were \$ 885,600. Of this total, \$664,336 or 75.0% was spent for prescribed drugs, and \$ 165,183 or 18.7% was spent for physician services. Medical expenses were paid for 1,835 recipients for an average expenditure of \$482.62 per recipient.

Food And Nutrition Services Benefits (FNS) (Food Stamps)


Total persons participating in the FNS benefits program during August 2008 increased to 1,178,612 by 4,279 or 0.4% from 1,174,333 persons reported in July 2008. Households increased by 2,313 or 0.4% over July 2008 levels. The total dollar value of FNS related benefits issued during August 2008 increased by \$ 138,404 or 0.1% from \$125,593,602 reported in July 2008 to \$125,732,006 reported in August 2008. The average benefit issuance per person decreased by \$ 0.27 or -0.3% from those issued in July 2008. The average benefit issuance per person decreased from \$106.95 reported in July 2008 to \$106.68 reported in August 2008.

Please note: All data in the PAMS report is limited to the information available at the time it was constructed. It does not account for backdated or retroactive eligibility or any adjustments made subsequent to its creation.




No of OWF Combined Assistance Groups During The Last 25 Months







Food Stamp Benefits Cash Recipients During The Last 25 Months


