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Monthly Review of Public Assistance Statistics for October 2008

Ohio Works First (OWF)

For the month of October 2008, OWF-Combined assistance groups totaled 82,450; recipients totaled 179,595 and money payments totaled \$28,180,739. The percent change from September 2008 to October 2008 was 2.0% for assistance groups; 2.5% for recipients, and 2.4% for money payments. For OWF- Regular (OWF-R) there were 78,293 assistance groups; 163,064 recipients, and \$26,314,319 in money payments issued for October 2008. The percent change from September 2008 to October 2008 was 1.7% for assistance groups; 1.8% for recipients, and 2.0% for money payments. For OWF-Unemployed (OWF-U), assistance groups totaled 4,157, recipients, 16,531 and money payments were \$1,866,420. The percent change from September 2008 to October 2008 was 8.6% for assistance groups; 9.1% for recipients and 7.6% for money payments.

Foster Care (TITLE IV-E)

Disability Assistance (DA)

For the month of October 2008, there were 17,098 assistance groups; 17,187 recipients, and \$2,176,129 in DA financial assistance. The average DA financial assistance per recipient was \$126.61. Total DA expenditures for medical services for October 2008 were \$1,061,313. Of this total, \$765,881 or 72.2% was spent for prescribed drugs, and \$223,263 or 21.0% was spent for physician services. Medical expenses were paid for 1,780 recipients for an average expenditure of \$596.24 per recipient.

Food And Nutrition Services Benefits (FNS) (Food Stamps)


Total persons participating in the FNS benefits program during October 2008 decreased to 1,207,998 by 6,937 or -0.6% from 1,214,935 persons reported in September 2008. Households decreased by 1,368 or -0.2% over September 2008 levels. The total dollar value of FNS related benefits issued during October 2008 decreased by \$9,606,093 or -6.0% from \$160,278,632 reported in September 2008 to \$150,672,539 reported in October 2008. The average benefit issuance per person decreased by \$7.19 or -5.5% from those issued in September 2008. The average benefit issuance per person decreased from \$131.92 reported in September 2008 to \$124.73 reported in October 2008.

Please note: All data in the PAMS report is limited to the information available at the time it was constructed. It does not account for backdated or retroactive eligibility or any adjustments made subsequent to its creation.



No of OWF Combined Net Expenditure During The Last 25 Months






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



Food Stamp Benefits Cash Recipients During The Last 25 Months


