## Monthly Review of Public Assistance Statistics for November 2008

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### Ohio Works First (OWF)

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For the month of November 2008, OWF-Combined assistance groups totaled 82,930; recipients totaled 179,912 and money payments totaled \$27,831,009. The percent change from October 2008 to November 2008 was 0.6% for assistance groups; 0.2% for recipients, and -1.2% for money payments. For OWF- Regular (OWF-R) there were 78,546 assistance groups; 162,772 recipients, and \$25,917,347 in money payments issued for November 2008. The percent change from October 2008 to November 2008 was 0.3% for assistance groups; -0.2% for recipients, and -1.5% for money payments. For OWF-Unemployed (OWF-U), assistance groups totaled 4,384, recipients, 17,140 and money payments were \$1,913,662. The percent change from October 2008 to November 2008 was 5.5% for assistance groups; 3.7% for recipients and 2.5% for money payments.

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### Foster Care (TITLE IV-E)

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### Disability Assistance (DA)

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For the month of November 2008, there were 16,708 assistance groups; 16,795 recipients, and \$2,147,042 in DA financial assistance. The average DA financial assistance per recipient was \$127.84. Total DA expenditures for medical services for November 2008 were \$824,423. Of this total, \$600,221 or 72.8% was spent for prescribed drugs, and \$161,138 or 19.5% was spent for physician services. Medical expenses were paid for 1,679 recipients for an average expenditure of \$491.02 per recipient.

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### Food And Nutrition Services Benefits (FNS) (Food Stamps)

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Total persons participating in the FNS benefits program during November 2008 increased to 1,223,230 by 15,232 or 1.3% from 1,207,998 persons reported in October 2008. Households increased by 7,747 or 1.4% over October 2008 levels. The total dollar value of FNS related benefits issued during November 2008 increased by \$1,082,332 or 0.7% from \$150,672,539 reported in October 2008 to \$151,754,871 reported in November 2008. The average benefit issuance per person decreased by \$0.67 or -0.5% from those issued in October 2008. The average benefit issuance per person decreased from \$124.73 reported in October 2008 to \$124.06 reported in November 2008.





## No of OWF Combined Net Expenditure During The Last 25 Months







## Food Stamp Benefits Cash Recipients During The Last 25 Months


