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Monthly Review of Public Assistance Statistics for December 2008

Ohio Works First (OWF)

For the month of December 2008, OWF-Combined assistance groups totaled 85,265; recipients totaled 187,842 and money payments totaled \$29,906,459. The percent change from November 2008 to December 2008 was 2.8% for assistance groups; 4.4% for recipients, and 7.5% for money payments. For OWF- Regular (OWF-R) there were 80,423 assistance groups; 168,378 recipients, and \$27,593,597 in money payments issued for December 2008. The percent change from November 2008 to December 2008 was 2.4% for assistance groups; 3.4% for recipients, and 6.5% for money payments. For OWF-Unemployed (OWF-U), assistance groups totaled 4,842, recipients, 19,464 and money payments were \$2,312,862. The percent change from November 2008 to December 2008 was 10.4% for assistance groups; 13.6% for recipients and 20.9% for money payments.

Foster Care (TITLE IV-E)

Disability Assistance (DA)

For the month of December 2008, there were 16,694 assistance groups; 16,779 recipients, and \$2,184,148 in DA financial assistance. The average DA financial assistance per recipient was \$130.17. Total DA expenditures for medical services for December 2008 were \$976,080. Of this total, \$740,252 or 75.8% was spent for prescribed drugs, and \$172,777 or 17.7% was spent for physician services. Medical expenses were paid for 1,640 recipients for an average expenditure of \$595.17 per recipient.

Food And Nutrition Services Benefits (FNS) (Food Stamps)


Total persons participating in the FNS benefits program during December 2008 increased to 1,264,464 by 41,234 or 3.4% from 1,223,230 persons reported in November 2008. Households increased by 17,757 or 3.2% over November 2008 levels. The total dollar value of FNS related benefits issued during December 2008 increased by \$4,680,083 or 3.1% from \$151,754,871 reported in November 2008 to \$156,434,954 reported in December 2008. The average benefit issuance per person decreased by \$0.34 or -0.3% from those issued in November 2008. The average benefit issuance per person decreased from \$124.06 reported in November 2008 to \$123.72 reported in December 2008.

Please note: All data in the PAMS report is limited to the information available at the time it was constructed. It does not account for backdated or retroactive eligibility or any adjustments made subsequent to its creation.




No of OWF Combined Assistance Groups During The Last 25 Months







Food Stamp Benefits Cash Recipients During The Last 25 Months


