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Monthly Review of Public Assistance Statistics for January 2009

Ohio Works First (OWF)

For the month of January 2009, OWF-Combined assistance groups totaled 84,674; recipients totaled 186,985 and money payments totaled \$30,374,415. The percent change from December 2008 to January 2009 was -0.7% for assistance groups; -0.5% for recipients, and 1.6% for money payments. For OWF- Regular (OWF-R) there were 79,508 assistance groups; 166,342 recipients, and \$27,868,195 in money payments issued for January 2009. The percent change from December 2008 to January 2009 was -1.1% for assistance groups; -1.2% for recipients, and 1.0% for money payments. For OWF-Unemployed (OWF-U), assistance groups totaled 5,168, recipients, 20,643 and money payments were \$2,506,220. The percent change from December 2008 to January 2009 was 6.7% for assistance groups; 6.1% for recipients and 8.4% for money payments.

Foster Care (TITLE IV-E)

Disability Assistance (DA)

For the month of January 2009, there were 16,342 assistance groups; 16,420 recipients, and \$2,159,334 in DA financial assistance. The average DA financial assistance per recipient was \$131.51. Total DA expenditures for medical services for January 2009 were \$718,555. Of this total, \$559,575 or 77.9% was spent for prescribed drugs, and \$113,101 or 15.7% was spent for physician services. Medical expenses were paid for 1,535 recipients for an average expenditure of \$468.11 per recipient.

Food And Nutrition Services Benefits (FNS) (Food Stamps)


Total persons participating in the FNS benefits program during January 2009 increased to 1,287,349 by 22,885 or 1.8% from 1,264,464 persons reported in December 2008. Households increased by 11,815 or 2.0% over December 2008 levels. The total dollar value of FNS related benefits issued during January 2009 decreased by \$260,470 or -0.2% from \$156,434,954 reported in December 2008 to \$156,174,484 reported in January 2009. The average benefit issuance per person decreased by \$2.41 or -1.9% from those issued in December 2008. The average benefit issuance per person decreased from \$123.72 reported in December 2008 to \$121.31 reported in January 2009.

Please note: All data in the PAMS report is limited to the information available at the time it was constructed. It does not account for backdated or retroactive eligibility or any adjustments made subsequent to its creation.




No of OWF Combined Assistance Groups During The Last 25 Months







Food Stamp Benefits Cash Recipients During The Last 25 Months


