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Monthly Review of Public Assistance Statistics for March 2009

Ohio Works First (OWF)

For the month of March 2009, OWF-Combined assistance groups totaled 88,009; recipients totaled 195,851 and money payments totaled \$32,017,632. The percent change from February 2009 to March 2009 was 2.5% for assistance groups; 3.1% for recipients, and 2.8% for money payments. For OWF- Regular (OWF-R) there were 82,022 assistance groups; 172,122 recipients, and \$29,108,347 in money payments issued for March 2009. The percent change from February 2009 to March 2009 was 2.2% for assistance groups; 2.5% for recipients, and 2.3% for money payments. For OWF-Unemployed (OWF-U), assistance groups totaled 5,987, recipients, 23,729 and money payments were \$2,909,285. The percent change from February 2009 to March 2009 was 7.4% for assistance groups; 7.5% for recipients and 7.7% for money payments.

Foster Care (TITLE IV-E)

Disability Assistance (DA)

For the month of March 2009, there were 16,355 assistance groups; 16,436 recipients, and \$2,207,876 in DA financial assistance. The average DA financial assistance per recipient was \$134.33. Total DA expenditures for medical services for March 2009 were \$794,875. Of this total, \$591,406 or 74.4% was spent for prescribed drugs, and \$150,254 or 18.9% was spent for physician services. Medical expenses were paid for 1,494 recipients for an average expenditure of \$532.04 per recipient.

Food And Nutrition Services Benefits (FNS) (Food Stamps)


Total persons participating in the FNS benefits program during March 2009 increased to 1,342,827 by 35,924 or 2.7% from 1,306,903 persons reported in February 2009. Households increased by 16,878 or 2.8% over February 2009 levels. The total dollar value of FNS related benefits issued during March 2009 increased by \$6,483,243 or 4.0% from \$160,137,300 reported in February 2009 to \$166,620,543 reported in March 2009. The average benefit issuance per person increased by \$1.55 or 1.3% from those issued in February 2009. The average benefit issuance per person increased from \$122.53 reported in February 2009 to \$124.08 reported in March 2009.

Please note: All data in the PAMS report is limited to the information available at the time it was constructed. It does not account for backdated or retroactive eligibility or any adjustments made subsequent to its creation.



No of OWF Combined Assistance Groups During The Last 25 months




No of OWF Combined Recipients







During Last 25 Months


