## Monthly Review of Public Assistance Statistics for June 2009

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### Ohio Works First (OWF)

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For the month of June 2009, OWF-Combined assistance groups totaled 93,184; recipients totaled 210,237 and money payments totaled \$34,221,818. The percent change from May 2009 to June 2009 was 2.4% for assistance groups; 3.0% for recipients, and 2.6% for money payments. For OWF- Regular (OWF-R) there were 86,539 assistance groups; 184,061 recipients, and \$31,055,923 in money payments issued for June 2009. The percent change from May 2009 to June 2009 was 2.3% for assistance groups; 2.8% for recipients, and 2.4% for money payments. For OWF-Unemployed (OWF-U), assistance groups totaled 6,645, recipients, 26,176 and money payments were \$3,165,895. The percent change from May 2009 to June 2009 was 4.4% for assistance groups; 4.7% for recipients and 4.0% for money payments.

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### Disability Assistance (DA)

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For the month of June 2009, there were 15,375 assistance groups; 15,446 recipients, and \$2,054,438 in DA financial assistance. The average DA financial assistance per recipient was \$133.01. Total DA expenditures for medical services for June 2009 were \$699,633. Of this total, \$522,346 or 74.7% was spent for prescribed drugs, and \$132,136 or 18.9% was spent for physician services. Medical expenses were paid for 1,335 recipients for an average expenditure of \$524.07 per recipient.

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### Food And Nutrition Services Benefits (FNS) (Food Stamps)

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Total persons participating in the FNS benefits program during June 2009 increased to 1,442,320 by 40,757 or 2.9% from 1,401,563 persons reported in May 2009. Households increased by 18,358 or 2.8% over May 2009 levels. The total dollar value of FNS related benefits issued during June 2009 increased by \$6,177,195 or 3.1% from \$199,306,668 reported in May 2009 to \$205,483,863 reported in June 2009. The average benefit issuance per person increased by \$ 0.27 or 0.2% from those issued in May 2009. The average benefit issuance per person increased from \$142.20 reported in May 2009 to \$142.47 reported in June 2009.


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


### No of OWF Combined Assistance Groups During The Last 25 months






# Food Stamp Benefits Assistance Groups
