Monthly Review of Public Assistance Statistics for July 2009

Ohio Works First (OWF)

For the month of July 2009, OWF-Combined assistance groups totaled 94,470; recipients totaled 214,060 and money payments totaled \$34,546,779. The percent change from June 2009 to July 2009 was 1.4% for assistance groups; 1.8% for recipients, and 0.9% for money payments. For OWF- Regular (OWF-R) there were 87,654 assistance groups; 187,274 recipients, and \$31,286,135 in money payments issued for July 2009. The percent change from June 2009 to July 2009 was 1.3% for assistance groups; 1.7% for recipients, and 0.7% for money payments. For OWF-Unemployed (OWF-U), assistance groups totaled 6,816, recipients, 26,786 and money payments were \$3,260,644. The percent change from June 2009 to July 2009 was 2.6% for assistance groups; 2.3% for recipients and 3.0% for money payments.

Foster Care (TITLE IV-E)

Disability Assistance (DA)

For the month of July 2009, there were 15,037 assistance groups; 15,100 recipients, and \$1,963,800 in DA financial assistance. The average DA financial assistance per recipient was \$130.05. Total DA expenditures for medical services for July 2009 were \$767,709. Of this total, \$598,663 or 78.0% was spent for prescribed drugs, and \$118,055 or 15.4% was spent for physician services. Medical expenses were paid for 1,306 recipients for an average expenditure of \$587.83 per recipient.

Food And Nutrition Services Benefits (FNS) (Food Stamps)


Total persons participating in the FNS benefits program during July 2009 increased to 1,456,145 by 13,825 or 1.0% from 1,442,320 persons reported in June 2009. Households increased by 7,801 or 1.2% over June 2009 levels. The total dollar value of FNS related benefits issued during July 2009 decreased by \$74,477 or -0.0% from \$205,483,863 reported in June 2009 to \$205,409,386 reported in July 2009. The average benefit issuance person decreased by \$1.41 or -1.0% from those issued in June 2009. The average benefit issuance per person increased from \$142.20 reported in May 2009 to \$142.37 reported in June 2009.



No of OWF Combined Assistance Groups During The Last 25 months




No of OWF Combined Recipients During The Last 25 Months






Food Stamp Benefits Assistance Groups
