Monthly Review of Public Assistance Statistics for September 2009

Ohio Works First (OWF)

For the month of September 2009, OWF-Combined assistance groups totaled 98,009; recipients totaled 224,289 and money payments totaled \$35,998,248. The percent change from August 2009 to September 2009 was 2.7% for assistance groups; 3.5% for recipients, and 3.3% for money payments. For OWF- Regular (OWF-R) there were 90,558 assistance groups; 194,889 recipients, and \$32,455,656 in money payments issued for September 2009. The percent change from August 2009 to September 2009 was 2.4% for assistance groups; 3.0% for recipients, and 3.0% for money payments. For OWF-Unemployed (OWF-U), assistance groups totaled 7,451, recipients, 29,400 and money payments were \$3,542,592. The percent change from August 2009 to September 2009 was 6.7% for assistance groups; 6.9% for recipients and 6.0% for money payments.

Foster Care (TITLE IV-E)

Disability Assistance (DA)

For the month of September 2009, there were 14,688 assistance groups; 14,749 recipients, and \$1,981,285 in DA financial assistance. The average DA financial assistance per recipient was \$134.33. Total DA expenditures for medical services for September 2009 were \$728,577. Of this total, \$530,854 or 72.9% was spent for prescribed drugs, and \$147,418 or 20.2% was spent for physician services. Medical expenses were paid for 1,403 recipients for an average expenditure of \$519.30 per recipient.

Food And Nutrition Services Benefits (FNS) (Food Stamps)


Total persons participating in the FNS benefits program during September 2009 increased to 1,503,969 by 23,042 or 1.6% from 1,480,927 persons reported in August 2009. Households increased by 11,979 or 1.8% over August 2009 levels. The total dollar value of FNS related benefits issued during September 2009 increased by \$3,928,435 or 1.9% from \$209,866,667 reported in August 2009 to \$213,795,102 reported in September 2009. The average benefit issuance person increased by \$0.44 or 0.3% from those issued in August 2009. The average benefit issuance per person increased from \$141.71 reported in August 2009 to \$142.15 reported in September 2009.




No of OWF Combined Assistance Groups




Food Stamp Benefits Assistance Groups
