## Monthly Review of Public Assistance Statistics for November 2009

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### Ohio Works First (OWF)

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For the month of November 2009, OWF-Combined assistance groups totaled 100,729; recipients totaled 231,584 and money payments totaled \$37,419,693. The percent change from October 2009 to November 2009 was 1.0% for assistance groups; 1.2% for recipients, and 1.9% for money payments. For OWF- Regular (OWF-R) there were 92,684 assistance groups; 200,019 recipients, and \$33,562,234 in money payments issued for November 2009. The percent change from October 2009 to November 2009 was 0.8% for assistance groups; 1.0% for recipients, and 1.6% for money payments. For OWF-Unemployed (OWF-U), assistance groups totaled 8,045, recipients, 31,565 and money payments were \$3,857,459. The percent change from October 2009 to November 2009 was 3.5% for assistance groups; 2.8% for recipients and 5.0% for money payments.

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### Foster Care (TITLE IV-E)

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### Disability Assistance (DA)

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For the month of November 2009, there were 14,194 assistance groups; 14,249 recipients, and \$1,941,255 in DA financial assistance. The average DA financial assistance per recipient was \$136.24. Total DA expenditures for medical services for November 2009 were \$ 541,776. Of this total, \$397,170 or 73.3% was spent for prescribed drugs, and \$105,656 or 19.5% was spent for physician services. Medical expenses were paid for 1,130 recipients for an average expenditure of \$479.45 per recipient.

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### Food And Nutrition Services Benefits (FNS) (Food Stamps)

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Total persons participating in the FNS benefits program during November 2009 increased to 1,541,801 by 23,014 or 1.5% from 1,518,787 persons reported in October 2009. Households increased by 11,912 or 1.7% over October 2009 levels. The total dollar value of FNS related benefits issued during November 2009 increased by \$2,301,447 or 1.1% from \$215,506,007 reported in October 2009 to \$217,807,454 reported in November 2009. The average benefit issuance person decreased by \$0.62 or 0.4% from those issued in October 2009. The average benefit issuance per person decreased from \$141.89 reported in October 2009 to \$141.27 reported in November 2009.





### No of OWF Combined Assistance Groups During The Last 25 months




### No of OWF Combined Recipients






# Food Stamp Benefits Assistance Groups
