## Monthly Review of Public Assistance Statistics for December 2009

---

### Ohio Works First (OWF)

---

For the month of December 2009, OWF-Combined assistance groups totaled 102,489; recipients totaled 236,423 and money payments totaled \$38,105,443. The percent change from November 2009 to December 2009 was 1.7% for assistance groups; 2.1% for recipients, and 1.8% for money payments. For OWF- Regular (OWF-R) there were 94,136 assistance groups; 203,565 recipients, and \$34,082,101 in money payments issued for December 2009. The percent change from November 2009 to December 2009 was 1.6% for assistance groups; 1.8% for recipients, and 1.5% for money payments. For OWF-Unemployed (OWF-U), assistance groups totaled 8,353, recipients, 32,858 and money payments were \$4,023,342. The percent change from November 2009 to December 2009 was 3.8% for assistance groups; 4.1% for recipients and 4.3% for money payments.

### Disability Assistance (DA)

---

For the month of December 2009, there were 14,098 assistance groups; 14,154 recipients, and \$1,884,137 in DA financial assistance. The average DA financial assistance per recipient was \$133.12. Total DA expenditures for medical services for December 2009 were \$ 35,960. Of this total, -\$932.45 or -2.6% was spent for prescribed drugs, and \$29,545 or 82.2% was spent for physician services. Medical expenses were paid for 327 recipients for an average expenditure of \$109.97 per recipient.

---

### Food And Nutrition Services Benefits (FNS) (Food Stamps)

---

Total persons participating in the FNS benefits program during December 2009 increased to 1,576,359 by 34,558 or 2.2% from 1,541,801 persons reported in November 2009. Households increased by 16,468 or 2.3% over November 2009 levels. The total dollar value of FNS related benefits issued during December 2009 increased by \$5,985,964 or 2.7% from \$217,807,454 reported in November 2009 to \$223,793,418 reported in December 2009. The average benefit issuance person increased by \$0.70 or 0.5% from those issued in November 2009. The average benefit issuance per person increased from \$141.27 reported in November 2009 to \$141.97 reported in December 2009.












