## Monthly Review of Public Assistance Statistics for February 2010

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### Ohio Works First (OWF)

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For the month of February 2010, OWF-Combined assistance groups totaled 99,220; recipients totaled 227,046 and money payments totaled \$37,390,100. The percent change from January 2010 to February 2010 was -0.1% for assistance groups; -0.4% for recipients, and 0.7% for money payments. For OWF- Regular (OWF-R) there were 91,132 assistance groups; 195,316 recipients, and \$33,381,948 in money payments issued for February 2010. The percent change from January 2010 to February 2010 was -0.1% for assistance groups; -0.5% for recipients, and 0.8% for money payments. For OWF-Unemployed (OWF-U), assistance groups totaled 8,088, recipients, 31,730 and money payments were \$4,008,152. The percent change from January 2010 to February 2010 was 0.1% for assistance groups; -0.3% for recipients and 0.0% for money payments.

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### Foster Care (TITLE IV-E)

### Disability Assistance (DA)

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For the month of February 2010, there were 13,630 assistance groups; 13,687 recipients, and \$1,926,389 in DA financial assistance. The average DA financial assistance per recipient was \$140.75. Total DA expenditures for medical services for February 2010 were \$11,969. Of this total, \$87 or 0.7% was spent for prescribed drugs, and \$7,879 or 65.8% was spent for physician services. Medical expenses were paid for 96 recipients for an average expenditure of \$124.68 per recipient.

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### Food And Nutrition Services Benefits (FNS) (Food Stamps)

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Total persons participating in the FNS benefits program during February 2010 increased to 1,580,704 by 988 or 0.1% from 1,579,716 persons reported in January 2010. Households increased by 1,737 or 0.2% over January 2010 levels. The total dollar value of FNS related benefits issued during February 2010 increased by \$1,130,832 or 0.5% from \$224,122,685 reported in January 2010 to \$225,253,517 reported in February 2010. The average benefit issuance person increased by \$0.62 or 0.4% from those issued in January 2010. The average benefit issuance per person increased from \$141.88 reported in January 2010 to \$142.50 reported in February 2010.

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



# No of OWF Combined Assistance Groups


During The Last 25 months







During Last 25 Months


