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## Monthly Review of Public Assistance Statistics for March 2010

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### Ohio Works First (OWF)

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For the month of March 2010, OWF-Combined assistance groups totaled 100,387; recipients totaled 230,766 and money payments totaled \$37,552,656. The percent change from February 2010 to March 2010 was 1.2% for assistance groups; 1.6% for recipients, and 0.4% for money payments. For OWF- Regular (OWF-R) there were 92,071 assistance groups; 198,279 recipients, and \$33,475,747 in money payments issued for March 2010. The percent change from February 2010 to March 2010 was 1.0% for assistance groups; 1.5% for recipients, and 0.3% for money payments. For OWF-Unemployed (OWF-U), assistance groups totaled 8,316, recipients, 32,487 and money payments were \$4,076,909. The percent change from February 2010 to March 2010 was 2.8% for assistance groups; 2.4% for recipients and 1.7% for money payments.

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### Foster Care (TITLE IV-E)

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### Disability Assistance (DA)

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For the month of March 2010, there were 13,849 assistance groups; 13,908 recipients, and \$1,999,049 in DA financial assistance. The average DA financial assistance per recipient was \$143.73. Total DA expenditures for medical services for March 2010 were \$11,772. Of this total, -\$960 or -8.2% was spent for prescribed drugs, and \$11,320 or 96.2% was spent for physician services. Medical expenses were paid for 87 recipients for an average expenditure of \$135.32 per recipient.

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### Food And Nutrition Services Benefits (FNS) (Food Stamps)

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Total persons participating in the FNS benefits program during March 2010 increased to 1,603,792 by 23,088 or 1.5% from 1,580,704 persons reported in February 2010. Households increased by 12,550 or 1.7% over February 2010 levels. The total dollar value of FNS related benefits issued during March 2010 increased by \$2,954,412 or 1.3% from \$225,253,517 reported in February 2010 to \$228,207,929 reported in March 2010. The average benefit issuance person decreased by \$0.21 or -0.1% from those issued in February 2010. The average benefit issuance per person decreased from \$142.50 reported in February 2010 to \$142.29 reported in March 2010.

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


# No of OWF Combined Assistance Groups

During The Last 25 months




# No of OWF Combined Recipients








