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Monthly Review of Public Assistance Statistics for April 2010

Ohio Works First (OWF)

For the month of April 2010, OWF-Combined assistance groups totaled 99,181; recipients totaled 226,766 and money payments totaled \$37,168,035. The percent change from March 2010 to April 2010 was -1.2% for assistance groups; -1.7% for recipients, and -1.0% for money payments. For OWF- Regular (OWF-R) there were 90,944 assistance groups; 194,507 recipients, and \$33,130,392 in money payments issued for April 2010. The percent change from March 2010 to April 2010 was -1.2% for assistance groups; -1.9% for recipients, and -1.0% for money payments. For OWF-Unemployed (OWF-U), assistance groups totaled 8,237, recipients, 32,259 and money payments were \$4,037,643. The percent change from March 2010 to April 2010 was -0.9% for assistance groups; -0.7% for recipients and -1.0% for money payments.

Foster Care (TITLE IV-E)

Disability Assistance (DA)

For the month of April 2010, there were 13,564 assistance groups; 13,619 recipients, and \$1,984,640 in DA financial assistance. The average DA financial assistance per recipient was \$145.73. Total DA expenditures for medical services for April 2010 were \$838. Medical expenses were paid for 47 recipients.

Food And Nutrition Services Benefits (FNS) (Food Stamps)

Total persons participating in the FNS benefits program during April 2010 increased to 1,611,531 by 7,739 or 0.5% from 1,603,792 persons reported in March 2010. Households increased by 5,175 or 0.7% over March 2010 levels. The total dollar value of FNS related benefits issued during April 2010 increased by \$356,125 or 0.2% from \$228,207,929 reported in March 2010 to \$228,564,054 reported in April 2010. The average benefit issuance person decreased by \$0.46 or -0.3% from those issued in March 2010. The average benefit issuance per person decreased from \$142.29 reported in March 2010 to \$141.83 reported in April 2010.





No of OWF Combined Assistance Groups


During The Last 25 months






Food Stamp Benefits Assistance Groups
