## Monthly Review of Public Assistance Statistics for May 2010

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### Ohio Works First (OWF)

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For the month of May 2010, OWF-Combined assistance groups totaled 98,846; recipients totaled 225,689 and money payments totaled \$37,015,111. The percent change from April 2010 to May 2010 was -0.3% for assistance groups; -0.5% for recipients, and -0.4% for money payments. For OWF- Regular (OWF-R) there were 90,784 assistance groups; 194,321 recipients, and \$33,063,851 in money payments issued for May 2010. The percent change from April 2010 to May 2010 was -0.2% for assistance groups; -0.1% for recipients, and -0.2% for money payments. For OWF-Unemployed (OWF-U), assistance groups totaled 8,062, recipients, 31,368 and money payments were \$3,951,260. The percent change from April 2010 to May 2010 was -2.1% for assistance groups; -2.8% for recipients and -2.1% for money payments.

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### Foster Care (TITLE IV-E)

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Data not available due to SACWIS implementation.

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### Disability Assistance (DA)

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For the month of May 2010, there were 13,394 assistance groups; 13,449 recipients, and \$2,104,111 in DA financial assistance. The average DA financial assistance per recipient was \$156.45. Total DA expenditures for medical services for May 2010 were \$729. Medical expenses were paid for 36 recipients.

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### Food And Nutrition Services Benefits (FNS) (Food Stamps)

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Total persons participating in the FNS benefits program during May 2010 increased to 1,619,992 by 8,461 or 0.5% from 1,611,531 persons reported in April 2010. Households increased by 5,080 or 0.7% over April 2010 levels. The total dollar value of FNS related benefits issued during May 2010 increased by \$284,518 or 0.1% from \$228,564,054 reported in April 2010 to \$228,848,672 reported in May 2010. The average benefit issuance person decreased by \$0.56 or -0.4% from those issued in April 2010. The average benefit issuance per person decreased from \$141.83 reported in April 2010 to \$141.27 reported in May 2010.

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



# No of OWF Combined Assistance Groups


During The Last 25 months








# Food Stamp Benefits Assistance Groups
