#### Monthly Review of Public Assistance Statistics for July 2010

#### **Ohio Works First (OWF)**

For the month of July 2010, OWF-Combined assistance groups totaled 100,251; recipients totaled 230,216 and money payments totaled \$37,665,570. The percent change from June 2010 to July 2010 was -4.6% for assistance groups; -4.7% for recipients, and -19.9% for money payments. For OWF- Regular (OWF-R) there were 92,084 assistance groups; 198,088 recipients, and \$33,647,062 in money payments issued for July 2010. The percent change from June 2010 to July 2010 was -4.6% for assistance groups; -4.8% for recipients, and -20.6% for money payments. For OWF-Unemployed (OWF-U), assistance groups totaled 8,167, recipients, 32,128 and money payments were \$4,018,508. The percent change from June 2010 to July 2010 was -5.1% for assistance groups; -4.5% for recipients and -13.4% for money payments.

#### **Foster Care (TITLE IV-E)**

Data not available due to SACWIS implementation.

#### **Disability Assistance (DA)**

For the month of July 2010, there were 13,124 assistance groups; 13,177 recipients, and \$1,929,104 in DA financial assistance. The average DA financial assistance per recipient was \$146.40. Total DA expenditures for medical services for July 2010 were \$1,058. Medical expenses were paid for 20 recipients.

#### Food And Nutrition Services Benefits (FNS) (Food Stamps)

Total persons participating in the FNS benefits program during July 2010 increased to 1,652,927 by 6,848 or 0.4% from 1,646,079 persons reported in June 2010. Households increased by 4,625 or 0.6% over June 2010 levels. The total dollar value of FNS related benefits issued during July 2010 increased by \$852,537 or 0.4% from \$234,232,536 reported in June 2010 to \$235,085,073 reported in July 2010. The average benefit issuance person decreased by \$0.08 or -0.1% from those issued in June 2010. The average benefit issuance per person decreased from \$142.30 reported in June 2010 to \$142.22 reported in July 2010.




#### **No of OWF Combined Assistance Groups**

During The Last 25 Months






#### **DA Cash Assistance Group**




#### **Food Stamp Benefits Assistance Groups**
