Monthly Review of Public Assistance Statistics for August 2010

Ohio Works First (OWF)

For the month of August 2010, OWF-Combined assistance groups totaled 101,368; recipients totaled 233,227 and money payments totaled \$38,338,472. The percent change from July 2010 to August 2010 was 1.1% for assistance groups; 1.3% for recipients, and 1.8% for money payments. For OWF- Regular (OWF-R) there were 93,173 assistance groups; 200,843 recipients, and \$34,266,769 in money payments issued for August 2010. The percent change from July 2010 to August 2010 was 1.2% for assistance groups; 1.4% for recipients, and 1.8% for money payments. For OWF-Unemployed (OWF-U), assistance groups totaled 8,195, recipients, 32,384 and money payments were \$4,071,703. The percent change from July 2010 to August 2010 was 0.3% for assistance groups; 0.8% for recipients and 1.3% for money payments.

Foster Care (TITLE IV-E)

Data not available due to SACWIS implementation.

Disability Assistance (DA)

For the month of August 2010, there were 13,088 assistance groups; 13,136 recipients, and \$2,013,894 in DA financial assistance. The average DA financial assistance per recipient was \$153.31. Total DA expenditures for medical services for August 2010 were \$1,105. Medical expenses were paid for 13 recipients.

Food And Nutrition Services Benefits (FNS) (Food Stamps)

Total persons participating in the FNS benefits program during August 2010 increased to 1,670,261 by 17,334 or 1.0% from 1,652,927 persons reported in July 2010. Households increased by 9,967 or 1.3% over July 2010 levels. The total dollar value of FNS related benefits issued during August 2010 increased by \$3,668,945 or 1.6% from \$235,085,073 reported in July 2010 to \$238,754,018 reported in August 2010. The average benefit issuance person increased by \$0.72 or 1.6% from those issued in July 2010. The average benefit issuance per person increased from 142.22 reported in July 2010 to \$142.94 reported in August 2010.





During The Last 25 months




No of OWF Combined Recipients During The Last 25 Months








Food Stamp Benefits Assistance Groups
