Monthly Review of Public Assistance Statistics for September 2010

Ohio Works First (OWF)

For the month of September 2010, OWF-Combined assistance groups totaled 101,454; recipients totaled 233,204 and money payments totaled \$38,476,350. The percent change from August 2010 to September 2010 was 0.1% for assistance groups; -0.0% for recipients, and 0.4% for money payments. For OWF- Regular (OWF-R) there were 93,290 assistance groups; 200,967 recipients, and \$34,414,130 in money payments issued for September 2010. The percent change from August 2010 to September 2010 was 0.1% for assistance groups; 0.1% for recipients, and 0.4% for money payments. For OWF-Unemployed (OWF-U), assistance groups totaled 8,164, recipients, 32,237 and money payments were \$4,062,220. The percent change from August 2010 to September 2010 was -0.4% for assistance groups; -0.5% for recipients and -0.2% for money payments.

Foster Care (TITLE IV-E)

Data not available due to SACWIS implementation.

Disability Assistance (DA)

For the month of September 2010, there were 13,152 assistance groups; 13,193 recipients, and \$2,136,974 in DA financial assistance. The average DA financial assistance per recipient was \$161.98. Total DA expenditures for medical services for September 2010 were \$453. Medical expenses were paid for 14 recipients.

Food And Nutrition Services Benefits (FNS) (Food Stamps)

Total persons participating in the FNS benefits program during September 2010 increased to 1,683,437 by 13,176 or 0.8% from 1,670,261 persons reported in August 2010. Households increased by 8,307 or 1.1% over August 2010 levels. The total dollar value of FNS related benefits issued during September 2010 decreased by \$756,688 or -0.3% from \$238,754,018 reported in August 2010 to \$237,997,330 reported in September 2010. The average benefit issuance person decreased by \$1.56 or -1.1% from those issued in August 2010. The average benefit issuance per person decreased from \$142.94 reported in August 2010 to \$141.38 reported in September 2010.












Food Stamp Benefits Assistance Groups
