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Monthly Review of Public Assistance Statistics for October 2010

Ohio Works First (OWF)

For the month of October 2010, OWF-Combined assistance groups totaled 100,746; recipients totaled 231,234 and money payments totaled \$38,045,674. The percent change from September 2010 to October 2010 was -0.7% for assistance groups; -0.8% for recipients, and -1.1% for money payments. For OWF- Regular (OWF-R) there were 92,697 assistance groups; 199,519 recipients, and \$34,063,095 in money payments issued for October 2010. The percent change from September 2010 to October 2010 was -0.6% for assistance groups; -0.7% for recipients, and -1.0% for money payments. For OWF-Unemployed (OWF-U), assistance groups totaled 8,049, recipients totaled 31,715 and money payments were \$3,982,579. The percent change from September 2010 to October 2010 was -1.4% for assistance groups; -1.6% for recipients and -2.0% for money payments.

Foster Care (TITLE IV-E)

Disability Assistance (DA)

For the month of October 2010, there were 13,253 assistance groups; 13,289 recipients, and \$2,087,957 in DA financial assistance. The average DA financial assistance per recipient was \$157.12. Total DA expenditures for medical services for October 2010 were -\$2,855. Medical expenses were charged for 11 recipients.

Food And Nutrition Services Benefits (FNS) (Food Stamps)

Total persons participating in the FNS benefits program during October 2010 increased to 1,710,636 by 27,199 or 1.6% from 1,683,437 persons reported in September 2010. Households increased by 14,900 or 1.9% over September 2010 levels. The total dollar value of FNS related benefits issued during October 2010 decreased by \$639,506 or -0.3% from \$237,997,330 reported in September 2010 to \$237,357,824 reported in October 2010. The average benefit issuance per person decreased by \$2.63 or -1.9% from those issued in September 2010. The average benefit issuance per person decreased from \$141.38 reported in September 2010 to \$138.75 reported in October 2010.





Number of OWF Combined Assistance Groups


During The Last 25 months








