Monthly Review of Public Assistance Statistics for January 2011

Ohio Works First (OWF)

For the month of January 2011, OWF-Combined assistance groups totaled 99,337; recipients totaled 226,778 and money payments totaled \$37,104,273. The percent change from December 2010 to January 2011 was -1.7% for assistance groups; -2.2% for recipients, and -2.9% for money payments. For OWF- Regular (OWF-R) there were 91,279 assistance groups; 195,166 recipients, and \$33,170,816 in money payments issued for January 2011. The percent change from December 2010 to January 2011 was -1.8% for assistance groups; -2.3% for recipients, and -3.0% for money payments. For OWF-Unemployed (OWF-U), assistance groups totaled 8,058, recipients totaled 31,612 and money payments were \$3,933,457. The percent change from December 2010 to January 2011 was -0.9% for assistance groups; -1.1% for recipients and -2.4% for money payments.

Foster Care (TITLE IV-E)

Data not available due to SACWIS implementation.

Disability Assistance (DA)

For the month of January 2011, there were 13,346 assistance groups; 13,382 recipients, and \$1,983,918 in DA financial assistance. The average DA financial assistance per recipient was \$148.25. Total DA expenditures for medical services for January 2011 were -\$164. Medical expenses were charged for 5 recipients.

Food And Nutrition Services Benefits (FNS) (Food Stamps)

Total persons participating in the FNS benefits program during January 2011 increased to 1,805,861 by 10,654 or 0.6% from 1,795,207 persons reported in December 2010. Households increased by 5,705 or 0.7% over December 2010 levels. The total dollar value of FNS related benefits issued during January 2011 increased by \$1,000,705 or 0.4% from \$248,218,413 reported in December 2010 to \$249,219,118 reported in January 2011. The average benefit issuance per person decreased by \$0.26 or -0.2% from those issued in December 2010. The average benefit issuance per person decreased from \$138.27 reported in December 2010 to \$138.01 reported in January 2011.





Number of OWF Combined Assistance Groups


During The Last 25 months








