Monthly Review of Public Assistance Statistics for February 2011

Ohio Works First (OWF)

For the month of February 2011, OWF-Combined assistance groups totaled 97,502; recipients totaled 220,944 and money payments totaled \$36,289,712. The percent change from January 2011 to February 2011 was -1.8% for assistance groups; -2.6% for recipients, and -2.2% for money payments. For OWF- Regular (OWF-R) there were 89,710 assistance groups; 190,466 recipients, and \$32,489,451 in money payments issued for February 2011. The percent change from January 2011 to February 2011 was -1.7% for assistance groups; -2.4% for recipients, and -2.1% for money payments. For OWF-Unemployed (OWF-U), assistance groups totaled 7,792, recipients totaled 30,078 and money payments were \$3,800,261. The percent change from January 2011 to February 2011 was -3.3% for assistance groups; -3.6% for recipients and -3.4% for money payments.

Foster Care (TITLE IV-E)

Data not available due to SACWIS implementation.

Disability Assistance (DA)

For the month of February 2011, there were 13,330 assistance groups; 13,366 recipients, and \$1,918,587 in DA financial assistance. The average DA financial assistance per recipient was \$143.54. Total DA expenditures for medical services for February 2011 were -\$1,254. Medical expenses were charged for 24 recipients.

Food And Nutrition Services Benefits (FNS) (Food Stamps)

Total persons participating in the FNS benefits program during February 2011 increased to 1,806,808 by 947 or 0.1% from 1,805,861 persons reported in January 2011. Households increased by 1,610 or 0.2% over January 2011 levels. The total dollar value of FNS related benefits issued during February 2011 increased by \$1,746,301 or 0.7% from \$249,219,118 reported in January 2011 to \$250,965,419 reported in February 2011. The average benefit issuance per person increased by \$0.89 or 0.6% from those issued in January 2011. The average benefit issuance per person increased from \$138.01 reported in January 2011 to \$138.90 reported in February 2011.





Number of OWF Combined Assistance Groups


During The Last 25 months








