Monthly Review of Public Assistance Statistics for May 2011

Ohio Works First (OWF)

For the month of May 2011, OWF-Combined assistance groups totaled 94,998; recipients totaled 212,679 and money payments totaled \$35,206,469. The percent change from April 2011 to May 2011 was -0.5% for assistance groups; -0.8% for recipients, and 0.1% for money payments. For OWF- Regular (OWF-R) there were 87,538 assistance groups; 183,697 recipients, and \$31,567,742 in money payments issued for May 2011. The percent change from April 2011 to May 2011 was -0.4% for assistance groups; -0.7% for recipients, and 0.1% for money payments. For OWF-Unemployed (OWF-U), assistance groups totaled 7,460, recipients totaled 28,982 and money payments were \$3,638,727. The percent change from April 2011 to May 2011 was -1.3% for assistance groups; -1.3% for recipients and -0.1% for money payments.

Foster Care (TITLE IV-E)

Data not available due to SACWIS implementation.

Disability Assistance (DA)

For the month of May 2011, there were 13,286 assistance groups; 13,325 recipients, and \$1,832,252 in DA financial assistance. The average DA financial assistance per recipient was \$137.50. Total DA expenditures for medical services for May 2011 were -\$774. Medical expenses were charged for 8 recipients.

Food And Nutrition Services Benefits (FNS) (Food Stamps)

Total persons participating in the FNS benefits program during May 2011 decreased to 1,781,161 by -20,217 or -1.1% from 1,801,378 persons reported in April 2011. Households decreased by 6,325 or -0.7% over April 2011 levels. The total dollar value of FNS related benefits issued during May 2011 decreased by \$663,326 or -0.3% from \$252,611,691 reported in April 2011 to \$251,948,365 reported in May 2011. The average benefit issuance per person increased by \$1.22 or 0.9% from those issued in April 2011. The average benefit issuance per person increased from \$140.23 reported in April 2011 to \$141.45 reported in May 2011.





Number of OWF Combined Assistance Groups


During The Last 25 months








Food Stamp Benefits Assistance Groups
