## Monthly Review of Public Assistance Statistics for June 2011

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### Ohio Works First (OWF)

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For the month of June 2011, OWF-Combined assistance groups totaled 93,859; recipients totaled 209,600 and money payments totaled \$34,829,635. The percent change from May 2011 to June 2011 was -1.2% for assistance groups; -1.4% for recipients, and -1.1% for money payments. For OWF- Regular (OWF-R) there were 86,625 assistance groups; 181,550 recipients, and \$31,317,457 in money payments issued for June 2011. The percent change from May 2011 to June 2011 was -1.0% for assistance groups; -1.2% for recipients, and -0.8% for money payments. For OWF-Unemployed (OWF-U), assistance groups totaled 7,234, recipients totaled 28,050 and money payments were \$3,512,178. The percent change from May 2011 to June 2011 was -3.0% for assistance groups; -3.2% for recipients and -3.5% for money payments.

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### Foster Care (TITLE IV-E)

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Data not available due to SACWIS implementation.

### Disability Assistance (DA)

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For the month of June 2011, there were 13,222 assistance groups; 13,261 recipients, and \$1,894,090 in DA financial assistance. The average DA financial assistance per recipient was \$142.83. Total DA expenditures for medical services for June 2011 were \$50,676. Medical expenses were charged for 15 recipients.

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### Food And Nutrition Services Benefits (FNS) (Food Stamps)

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Total persons participating in the FNS benefits program during June 2011 decreased to 1,766,976 by -14,185 or -0.8% from 1,781,161 persons reported in May 2011. Households decreased by 5,766 or -0.7% over May 2011 levels. The total dollar value of FNS related benefits issued during June 2011 decreased by \$3,165,321 or -1.3% from \$251,948,365 reported in May 2011 to \$248,783,044 reported in June 2011. The average benefit issuance per person decreased by \$0.65 or -0.5% from those issued in May 2011. The average benefit issuance per person decreased from \$141.45 reported in May 2011 to \$140.80 reported in June 2011.

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



# Number of OWF Combined Assistance Groups


## During The Last 25 months








# Food Stamp Benefits Assistance Groups
