Monthly Review of Public Assistance Statistics for August 2011

Ohio Works First (OWF)

For the month of August 2011, OWF-Combined assistance groups totaled 92,684; recipients totaled 206,108 and money payments totaled \$34,460,681. The percent change from July 2011 to August 2011 was 0.6% for assistance groups; 0.7% for recipients, and 1.0% for money payments. For OWF- Regular (OWF-R) there were 85,729 assistance groups; 178,950 recipients, and \$31,060,781 in money payments issued for August 2011. The percent change from July 2011 to August 2011 was 0.6% for assistance groups; 0.7% for recipients, and 1.1% for money payments. For OWF-Unemployed (OWF-U), assistance groups totaled 6,955, recipients totaled 27,158 and money payments were \$3,399,900. The percent change from July 2011 to August 2011 was 0.4% for assistance groups; 1.0% for recipients and 0.6% for money payments.

Foster Care (TITLE IV-E)

Disability Assistance (DA)

For the month of August 2011, there were 13,152 assistance groups; 13,196 recipients, and \$1,894,429 in DA financial assistance. The average DA financial assistance per recipient was \$143.57. .

Food And Nutrition Services Benefits (FNS) (Food Stamps)


Total persons participating in the FNS benefits program during August 2011 increased to 1,765,171 by 8,943 or 0.5% from 1,756,228 persons reported in July 2011. Households increased by 5,357 or 0.6% over July 2011 levels. The total dollar value of FNS related benefits issued during August 2011 increased by \$1,337,091 or 0.5% from \$249,141,647 reported in July 2011 to \$250,478,738 reported in August 2011. The average benefit issuance per person increased by \$0.04 or 0.03% from those issued in July 2011. The average benefit issuance per person increased from \$141.86 reported in July 2011 to \$141.90 reported in August 2011.




Number of OWF Combined Assistance Groups During The Last 25 months








Food Stamp Benefits Assistance Groups
