Monthly Review of Public Assistance Statistics for September 2011

Ohio Works First (OWF)

For the month of September 2011, OWF-Combined assistance groups totaled 91,085; recipients totaled 201,641 and money payments totaled \$33,833,332. The percent change from August 2011 to September 2011 was -1.7% for assistance groups; -2.2% for recipients, and -1.8% for money payments. For OWF- Regular (OWF-R) there were 84,522 assistance groups; 176,078 recipients, and \$30,604,936 in money payments issued for September 2011. The percent change from August 2011 to September 2011 was -1.4% for assistance groups; -1.6% for recipients, and -1.5% for money payments. For OWF-Unemployed (OWF-U), assistance groups totaled 6,563, recipients totaled 25,563 and money payments were \$3,228,396. The percent change from August 2011 to September 2011 was -5.6% for assistance groups; -5.9% for recipients and -5.0% for money payments.

Foster Care (TITLE IV-E)

Disability Assistance (DA)

For the month of September 2011, there were 12,998 assistance groups; 13,042 recipients, and \$1,820,291 in DA financial assistance. The average DA financial assistance per recipient was \$139.57.

Food And Nutrition Services Benefits (FNS) (Food Stamps)


Total persons participating in the FNS benefits program during September 2011 decreased to 1,756,060 by 9,111 or -0.5% from 1,765,171 persons reported in August 2011. Households decreased by 2,566 or -0.3% over August 2011 levels. The total dollar value of FNS related benefits issued during September 2011 decreased by \$2,047,225 or -0.8% from \$250,478,738 reported in August 2011 to \$248,431,513 reported in September 2011. The average benefit issuance per person decreased by \$0.43 or -0.3% from those issued in August 2011. The average benefit issuance per person decreased from \$141.90 reported in August 2011 to \$141.47 reported in September 2011.




Number of OWF Combined Assistance Groups During The Last 25 months








