Monthly Review of Public Assistance Statistics for October 2011

Ohio Works First (OWF)

For the month of October 2011, OWF-Combined assistance groups totaled 89,425; recipients totaled 196,836 and money payments totaled \$33,348,823. The percent change from September 2011 to October 2011 was -1.8% for assistance groups; -2.4% for recipients, and -1.4% for money payments. For OWF- Regular (OWF-R) there were 83,204 assistance groups; 172,510 recipients, and \$30,299,067 in money payments issued for October 2011. The percent change from September 2011 to October 2011 was -1.6% for assistance groups; -2.0% for recipients, and -1.0% for money payments. For OWF-Unemployed (OWF-U), assistance groups totaled 6,221, recipients totaled 24,326 and money payments were \$3,049,756. The percent change from September 2011 to October 2011 was -5.2% for assistance groups; -4.8% for recipients and -5.5% for money payments.

Foster Care (TITLE IV-E)

Data not available due to SACWIS implementation.

Disability Assistance (DA)

For the month of October 2011, there were 12,826 assistance groups; 12,872 recipients, and \$1,742,827 in DA financial assistance. The average DA financial assistance per recipient was \$135.39.

Food And Nutrition Services Benefits (FNS) (Food Stamps)

Total persons participating in the FNS benefits program during October 2011 increased to 1,766,235 by 10,175 or 0.6% from 1,756,060 persons reported in September 2011. Households increased by 5,967 or 0.7% over September 2011 levels. The total dollar value of FNS related benefits issued during October 2011 increased by \$290,670 or 0.1% from \$248,431,513 reported in September 2011 to \$248,722,183 reported in October 2011. The average benefit issuance per person decreased by \$0.65 or -0.5% from those issued in September 2011. The average benefit issuance per person decreased from \$141.47 reported in September 2011 to \$140.82 reported in October 2011.





Number of OWF Combined Assistance Groups


During The Last 25 months








Food Stamp Benefits Assistance Groups
