Ohio Works First (OWF)

For the month of November 2011, OWF-Combined assistance groups totaled 86,918; recipients totaled 189,828 and money payments totaled \$32,029,971. The percent change from October 2011 to November 2011 was -2.8% for assistance groups; -3.6% for recipients, and -4.0% for money payments. For OWF- Regular (OWF-R) there were 81,025 assistance groups; 166,723 recipients, and \$29,130,131 in money payments issued for November 2011. The percent change from October 2011 to November 2011 was -2.6% for assistance groups; -3.4% for recipients, and -3.9% for money payments. For OWF-Unemployed (OWF-U), assistance groups totaled 5,893, recipients totaled 23,105 and money payments were \$2,899,840. The percent change from October 2011 to November 2011 was -5.3% for assistance groups; -5.0% for recipients and -4.9% for money payments.

Foster Care (TITLE IV-E)

Disability Assistance (DA)

For the month of November 2011, there were 12,602 assistance groups; 12,641 recipients, and \$1,671,980 in DA financial assistance. The average DA financial assistance per recipient was \$132.27.

Food And Nutrition Services Benefits (FNS) (Food Stamps)


Total persons participating in the FNS benefits program during November 2011 increased to 1,793,121 by 26,886 or 1.5% from 1,766,235 persons reported in October 2011. Households increased by 10,847 or 1.3% over October 2011 levels. The total dollar value of FNS related benefits issued during November 2011 increased by \$908,266 or 0.4% from \$248,722,183 reported in October 2011 to \$249,630,449 reported in November 2011. The average benefit issuance per person decreased by \$1.60 or -1.1% from those issued in October 2011. The average benefit issuance per person decreased from \$140.82 reported in October 2011 to \$139.22 reported in November 2011.

Please note: All data in the PAMS report is limited to the information available at the time it was constructed. It does not account for backdated or retroactive eligibility or any adjustments made subsequent to its creation.



No. of OWF Combined Assistance Groups During The Last 25 months




Number of OWF Combined Recipients During The Last 25 Months






