## Monthly Review of Public Assistance Statistics for December 2011

---

### Ohio Works First (OWF)

---

For the month of December 2011, OWF-Combined assistance groups totaled 86,283; recipients totaled 187,560 and money payments totaled \$32,271,399. The percent change from November 2011 to December 2011 was -0.7% for assistance groups; -1.2% for recipients, and 0.8% for money payments. For OWF- Regular (OWF-R) there were 80,550 assistance groups; 165,139 recipients, and \$29,355,486 in money payments issued for December 2011. The percent change from November 2011 to December 2011 was -0.6% for assistance groups; -1.0% for recipients, and 0.8% for money payments. For OWF-Unemployed (OWF-U), assistance groups totaled 5,733, recipients totaled 22,421 and money payments were \$2,915,913. The percent change from November 2011 to December 2011 was -2.7% for assistance groups; -3.0% for recipients and 0.6% for money payments.

### Disability Assistance (DA)

---

For the month of December 2011, there were 12,511 assistance groups; 12,554 recipients, and \$1,719,973 in DA financial assistance. The average DA financial assistance per recipient was \$130.01.

---

### Food And Nutrition Services Benefits (FNS) (Food Stamps)

---

Total persons participating in the FNS benefits program during December 2011 increased to 1,816,584 by 23,463 or 1.3% from 1,793,121 persons reported in November 2011. Households increased by 12,067 or 1.4% over November 2011 levels. The total dollar value of FNS related benefits issued during December 2011 increased by \$3,267,873 or 1.3% from \$249,630,449 reported in November 2011 to \$252,898,322 reported in December 2011. The average benefit issuance per person stayed relatively the same at \$139.22 which was reported for both November 2011 and December 2011.






## No. of OWF Combined Assistance Groups During The Last 25 months








