Monthly Review of Public Assistance Statistics for January 2012

Ohio Works First (OWF)

For the month of January 2011, OWF-Combined assistance groups totaled 83,561; recipients totaled 180,098 and money payments totaled \$31,566,020. The percent change from December 2011 to January 2012 was -3.2% for assistance groups; -4.0% for recipients, and -2.2% for money payments. For OWF- Regular (OWF-R) there were 78,153 assistance groups; 159,006 recipients, and \$28,810,813 in money payments issued for January 2012. The percent change from December 2011 to January 2011 was -3.0% for assistance groups; -3.7% for recipients, and -1.9% for money payments. For OWF-Unemployed (OWF-U), assistance groups totaled 5,408, recipients totaled 21,092 and money payments were \$2,755,207. The percent change from December 2011 to January 2012 was -5.7% for assistance groups; -5.9% for recipients and -5.5% for money payments.

Foster Care (TITLE IV-E)

Disability Assistance (DA)

For the month of January 2012, there were 12,331 assistance groups; 12,370 recipients, and \$1,678,446 in DA financial assistance. The average DA financial assistance per recipient was \$135.69.

Food And Nutrition Services Benefits (FNS) (Food Stamps)


Total persons participating in the FNS benefits program during January 2012 increased to 1,827,815 by 11,231 or 0.6% from 1,816,584 persons reported in December 2011. Households increased by 5,858 or 0.7% over December 2011 levels. The total dollar value of FNS related benefits issued during January 2012 decreased by \$184,710 or -0.1% from \$252,898,322 reported in December 2011 to \$252,713,612 reported in January 2012. The average benefit issuance per person decreased \$0.96 or -0.7% from those issued in December 2011. The average benefit issuance per person decreased from \$139.22 reported in December 2011 to \$138.26 reported in January 2012.




No. of OWF Combined Assistance Groups During The Last 25 months








