## Monthly Review of Public Assistance Statistics for February 2012

---

### Ohio Works First (OWF)

---

For the month of February 2012, OWF-Combined assistance groups totaled 81,662; recipients totaled 174,569 and money payments totaled \$30,825,434. The percent change from January 2012 to February 2012 was -2.3% for assistance groups; -3.1% for recipients, and -2.3% for money payments. For OWF- Regular (OWF-R) there were 76,470 assistance groups; 154,408 recipients, and \$28,173,971 in money payments issued for February 2012. The percent change from January 2012 to February 2012 was -2.2% for assistance groups; -2.9% for recipients, and -2.2% for money payments. For OWF-Unemployed (OWF-U), assistance groups totaled 5,192, recipients totaled 20,161 and money payments were \$2,651,463. The percent change from January 2012 to February 2012 was -4.0% for assistance groups; -4.4% for recipients and -3.8% for money payments.

### Disability Assistance (DA)

---

For the month of February 2012, there were 12,300 assistance groups; 12,341 recipients, and \$1,695,578 in DA financial assistance. The average DA financial assistance per recipient was \$137.39.

---

### Food And Nutrition Services Benefits (FNS) (Food Stamps)

---

Total persons participating in the FNS benefits program during February 2012 increased to 1,829,789 by 1,974 or 0.1% from 1,827,815 persons reported in January 2012. Households increased by 1,759 or 0.2% over January 2012 levels. The total dollar value of FNS related benefits issued during February 2012 decreased by \$776,586 or -0.3% from \$252,713,612 reported in January 2012 to \$251,937,026 reported in February 2012. The average benefit issuance per person decreased \$0.57 or -0.4% from those issued in January 2012. The average benefit issuance per person decreased from \$138.26 reported in January 2012 to \$137.69 reported in February 2012.

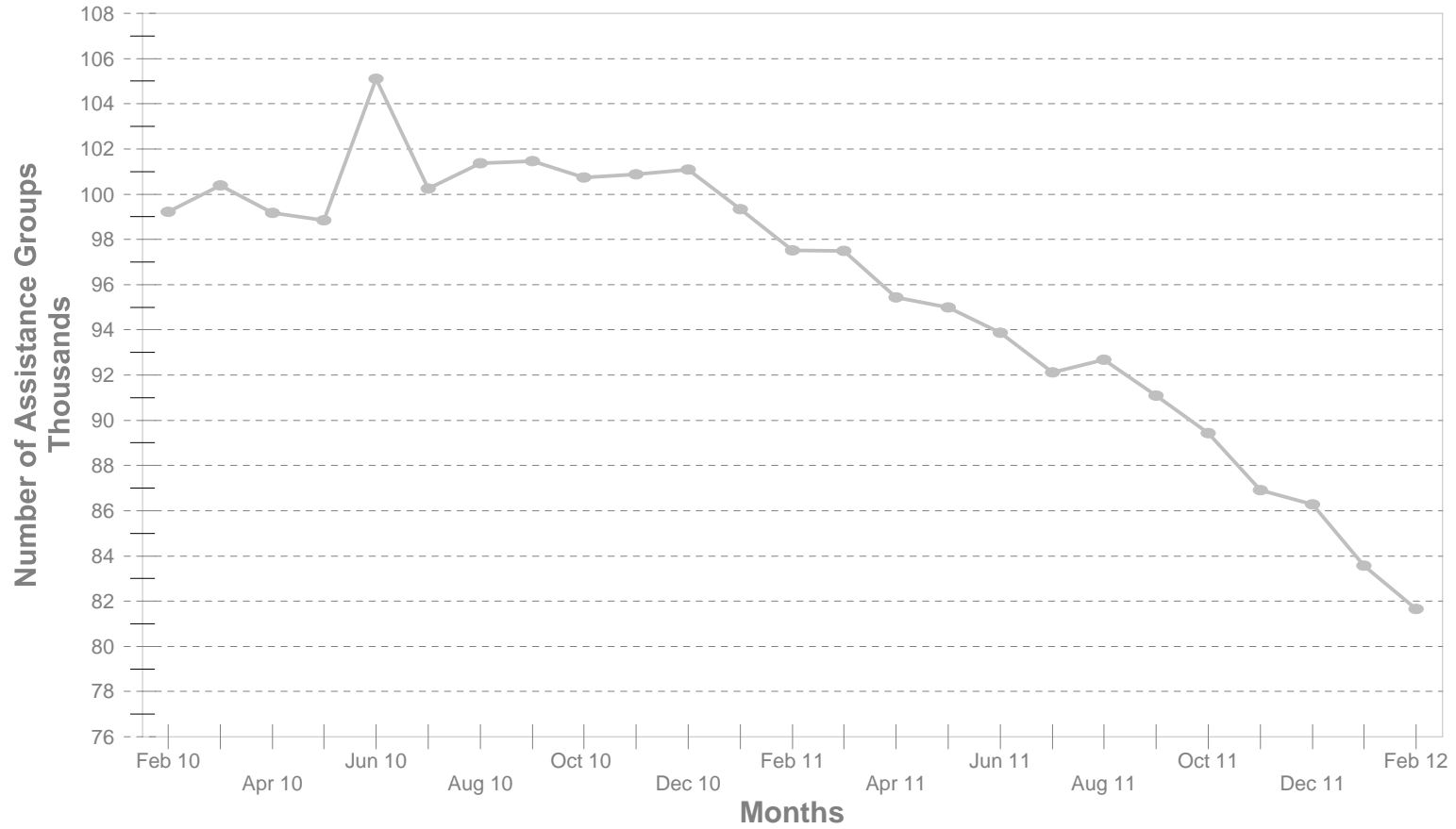

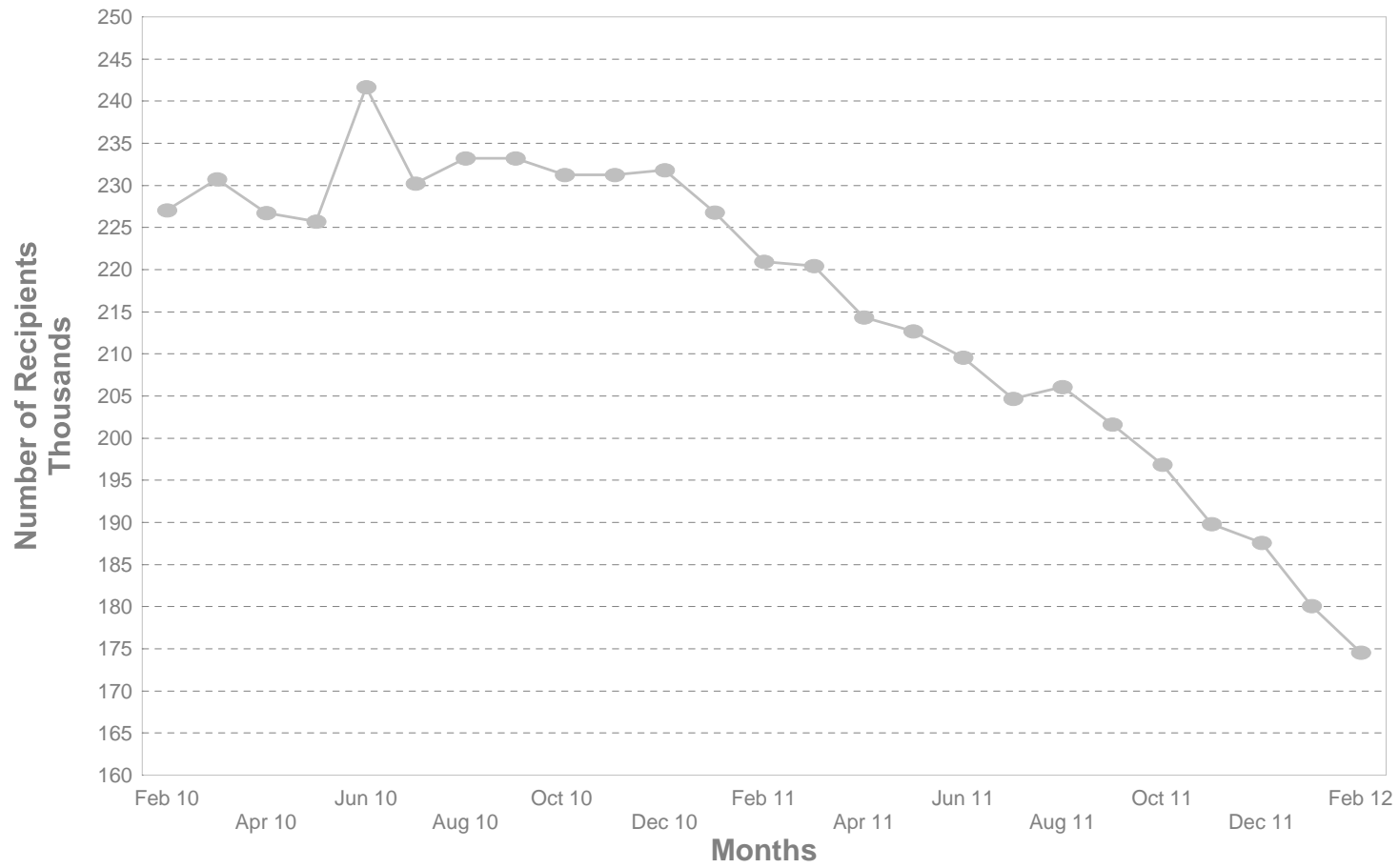

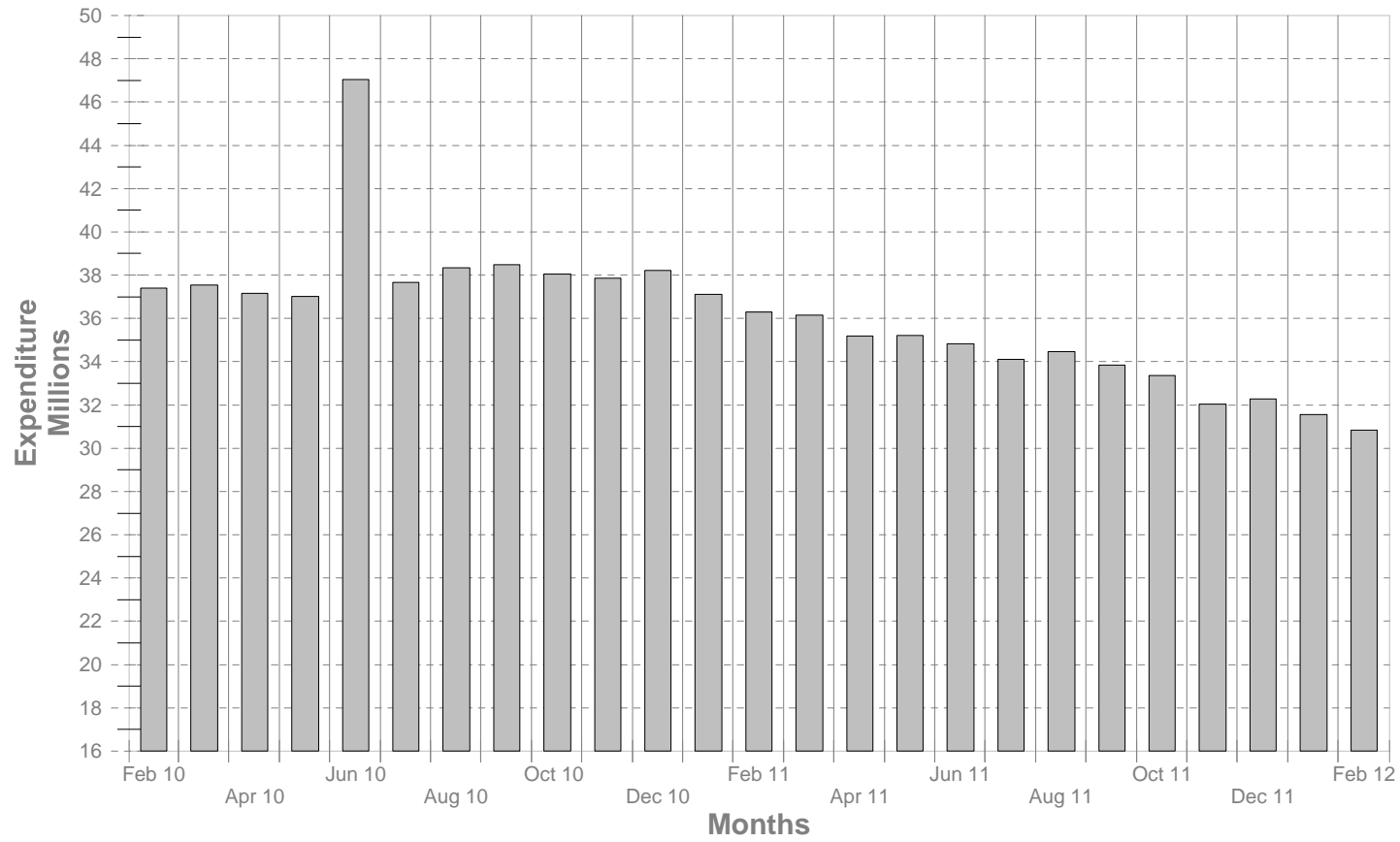
## No. of OWF Combined Assistance Groups During The Last 25 months

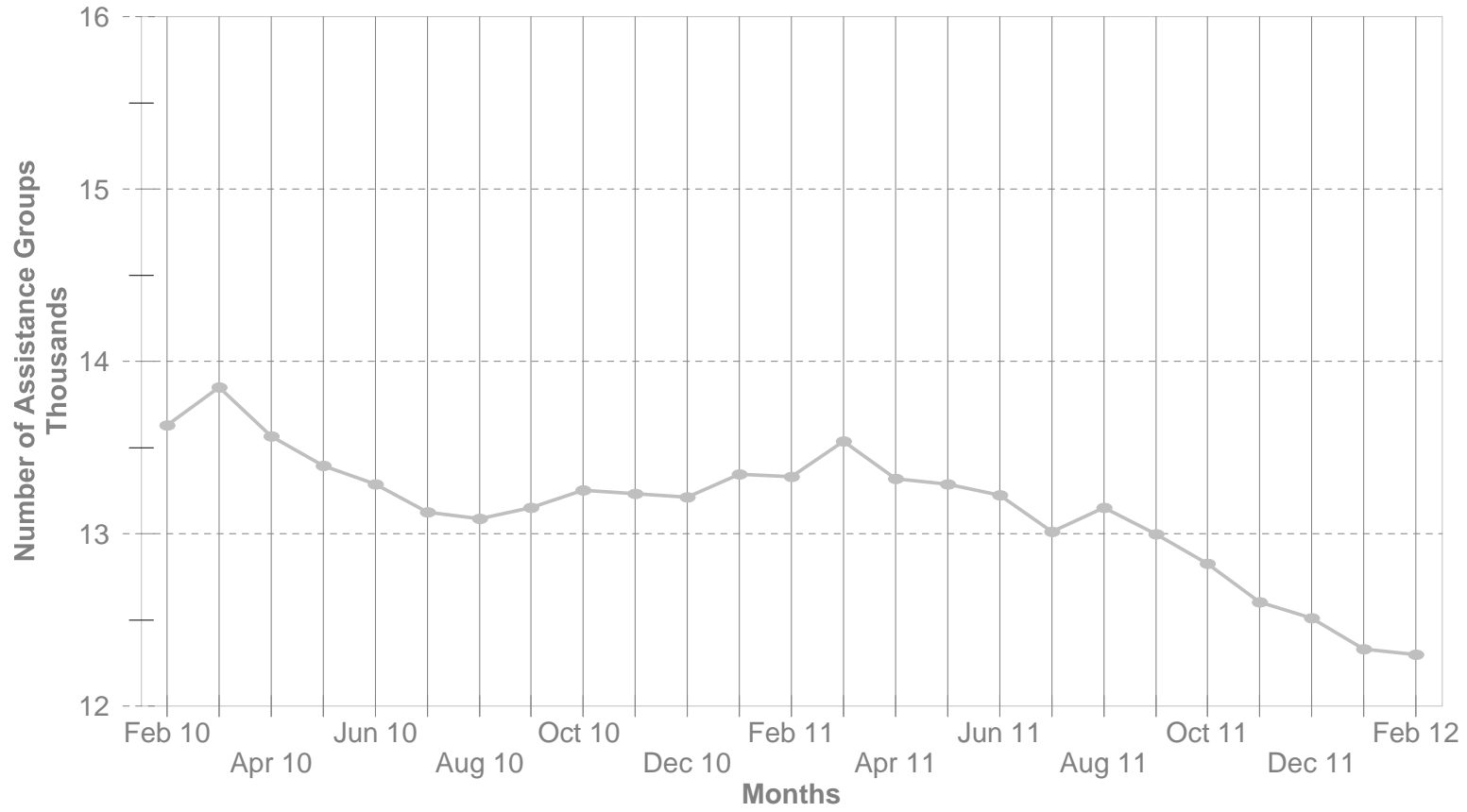

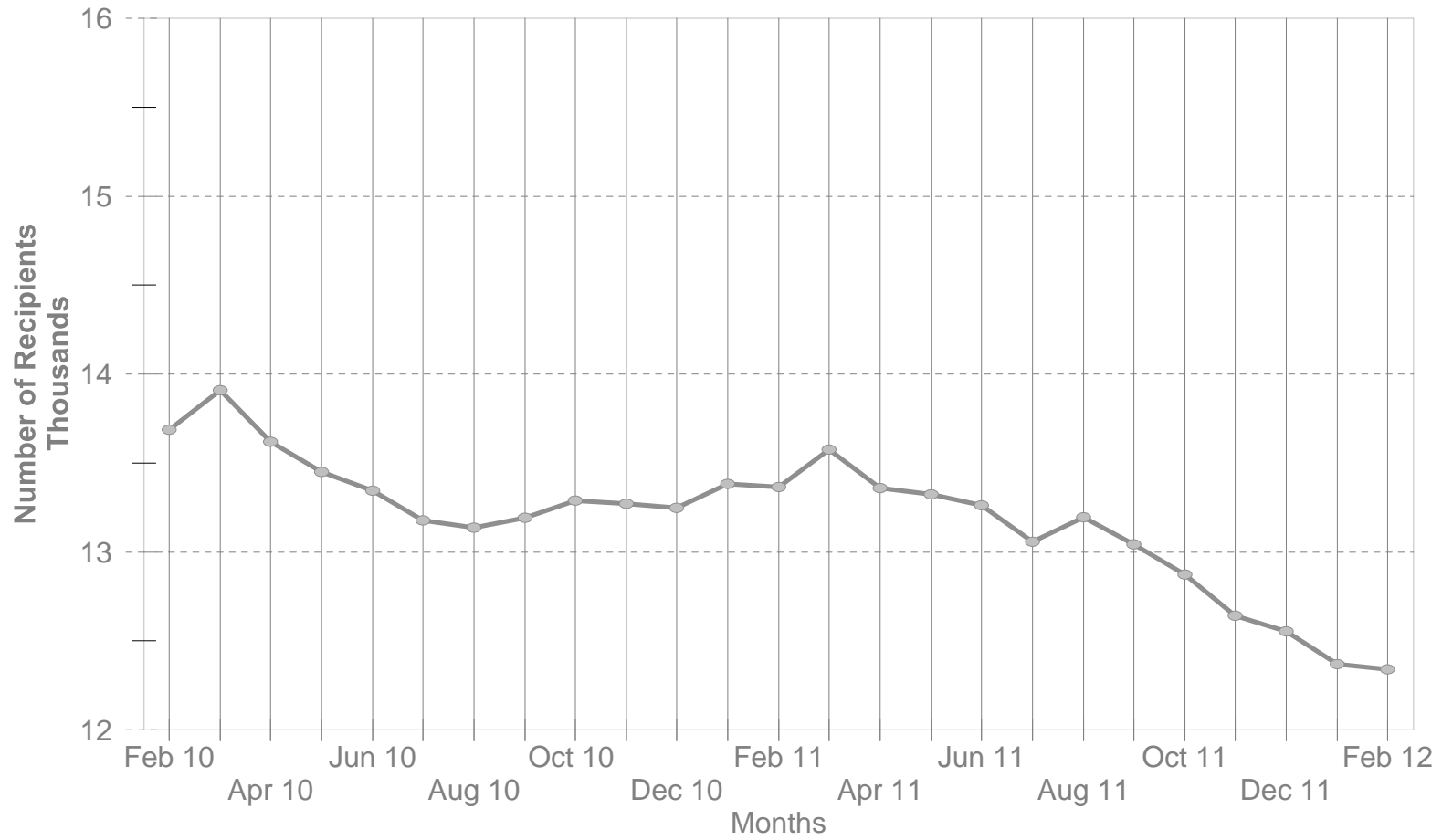
# DA Cash Assistance Group

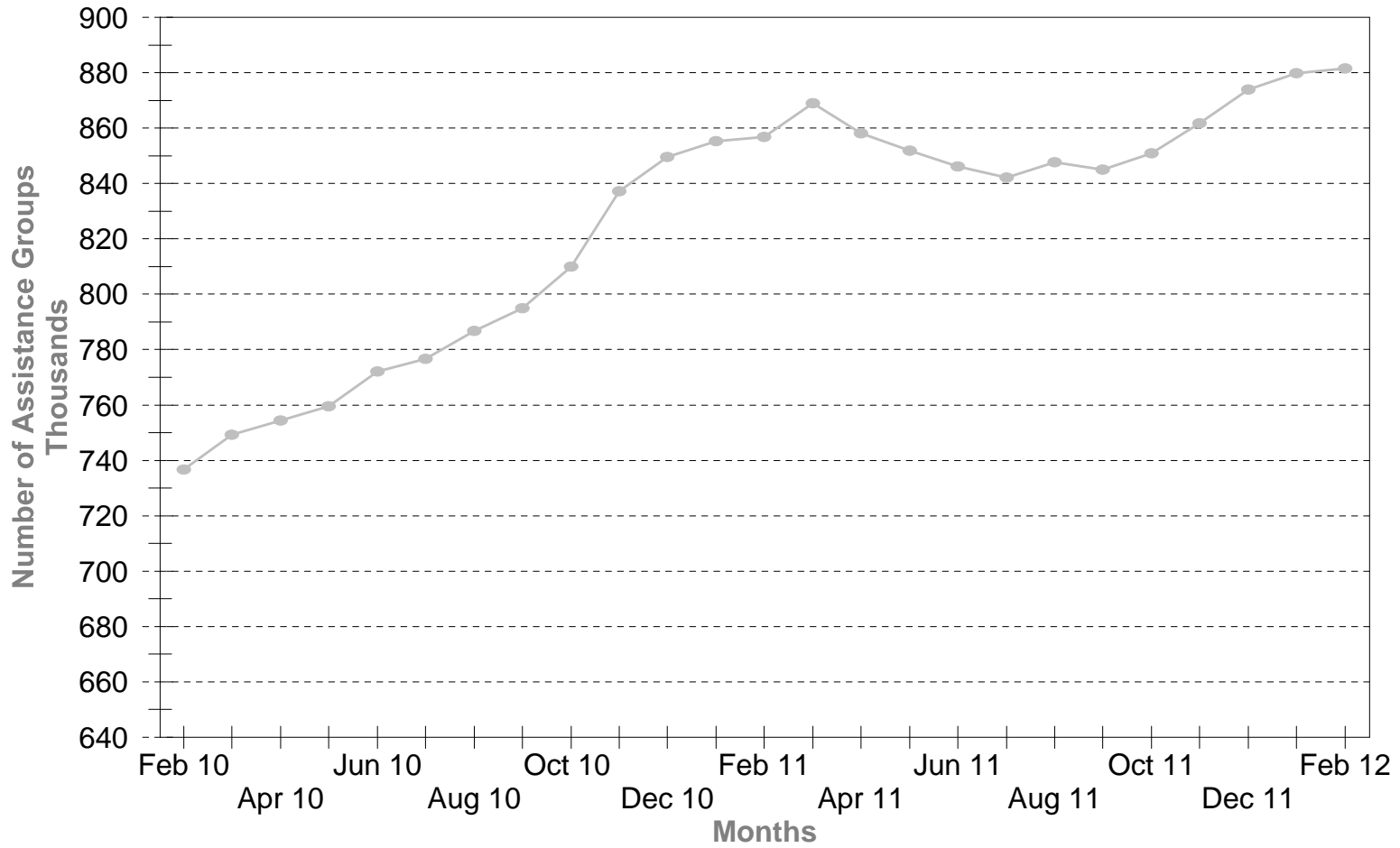

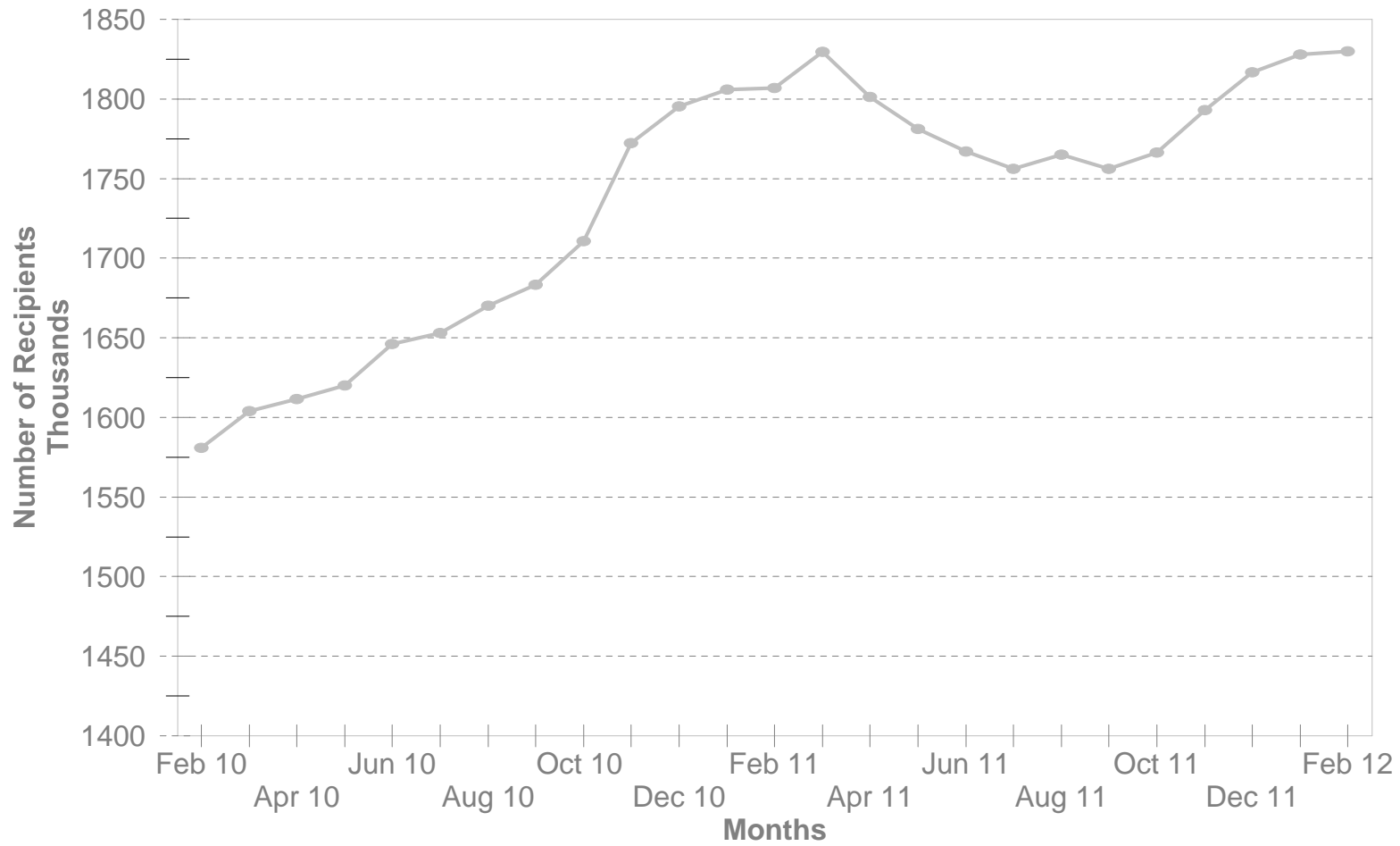
# Food Stamp Benefits Assistance Groups
