Monthly Review of Public Assistance Statistics for March 2012

Ohio Works First (OWF)

For the month of March 2012, OWF-Combined assistance groups totaled 79,136; recipients totaled 166,828 and money payments totaled \$29,574,559. The percent change from February 2012 to March 2012 was -3.1% for assistance groups; -4.4% for recipients, and -4.1% for money payments. For OWF- Regular (OWF-R) there were 74,369 assistance groups; 148,436 recipients, and \$27,142,456 in money payments issued for March 2012. The percent change from February 2012 to March 2012 was -2.7% for assistance groups; -3.9% for recipients, and -3.7% for money payments. For OWF-Unemployed (OWF-U), assistance groups totaled 4,767, recipients totaled 18,392 and money payments were \$2,432,103. The percent change from February 2012 to March 2012 was -8.2% for assistance groups; -8.8% for recipients and -8.3% for money payments.

Foster Care (TITLE IV-E)

Disability Assistance (DA)

For the month of March 2012, there were 12,275 assistance groups; 12,316 recipients, and \$1,755,508 in DA financial assistance. The average DA financial assistance per recipient was \$142.54.

Food And Nutrition Services Benefits (FNS) (Food Stamps)


Total persons participating in the FNS benefits program during March 2012 increased to 1,841,930 by 12,141 or 0.7% from 1,829,789 persons reported in February 2012. Households increased by 6,695 or 0.8% over February 2012 levels. The total dollar value of FNS related benefits issued during March 2012 increased by \$2,051,752 or 0.8% from \$251,937,026 reported in February 2012 to \$253,988,778 reported in March 2012. The average benefit issuance per person increased by \$0.20 or 0.1% from those issued in February 2012. The average benefit issuance per person




No. of OWF Combined Assistance Groups During The Last 25 months








