Monthly Review of Public Assistance Statistics for June 2012

Ohio Works First (OWF)

For the month of June 2012, OWF-Combined assistance groups totaled 74,716; recipients totaled 154,454 and money payments totaled \$27,689,000. The percent change from May 2012 to June 2012 was -2.2% for assistance groups; -2.9% for recipients, and -2.7% for money payments. For OWF- Regular (OWF-R) there were 70,711 assistance groups; 138,956 recipients, and \$25,669,901 in money payments issued for June 2012. The percent change from May 2012 to June 2012 was -1.7% for assistance groups; -2.2% for recipients, and -2.0% for money payments. For OWF-Unemployed (OWF-U), assistance groups totaled 4,005, recipients totaled 15,498 and money payments were \$2,019,099. The percent change from May 2012 to June 2012 was -9.0% for assistance groups; -8.6% for recipients and -10.3% for money payments.

Foster Care (TITLE IV-E)

Disability Assistance (DA)

For the month of June 2012, there were 12,000 assistance groups; 12,040 recipients, and \$1,696,989 in DA financial assistance. The average DA financial assistance per recipient was \$140.95.

Food And Nutrition Services Benefits (FNS) (Food Stamps)


Total persons participating in the FNS benefits program during June 2012 decreased to 1,790,592 by 12,742 or -0.7% from 1,803,334 persons reported in May 2012. Households decreased by 4,800 or -0.5% over May 2012 levels. The total dollar value of FNS related benefits issued during June 2012 decreased by \$2,868,746 or -1.2% from \$247,362,330 reported in May 2012 to \$244,493,584 reported in June 2012. The average benefit issuance per person decreased by \$0.63 or -0.5% from those issued in May 2012. The average benefit issuance per person




No. of OWF Combined Assistance Groups During The Last 25 months








