Monthly Review of Public Assistance Statistics for August 2012

Ohio Works First (OWF)

For the month of August 2012, OWF-Combined assistance groups totaled 72,373; recipients totaled 148,256 and money payments totaled \$26,976,471. The percent change from July 2012 to August 2012 was -1.5% for assistance groups; -2.1% for recipients, and -1.2% for money payments. For OWF- Regular (OWF-R) there were 68,757 assistance groups; 134,149 recipients, and \$25,109,419 in money payments issued for August 2012. The percent change from July 2012 to August 2012 was -1.2% for assistance groups; -1.6% for recipients, and -0.7% for money payments. For OWF-Unemployed (OWF-U), assistance groups totaled 3,616, recipients totaled 14,107 and money payments were \$1,867,052. The percent change from July 2012 to August 2012 was -6.9% for assistance groups; -6.8% for recipients and -6.4% for money payments.

Foster Care (TITLE IV-E)

Data not available due to SACWIS implementation.

Disability Assistance (DA)

For the month of August 2012, there were 11,831 assistance groups; 11,875 recipients, and \$1,679,209 in DA financial assistance. The average DA financial assistance per recipient was \$141.41.

Food And Nutrition Services Benefits (FNS) (Food Stamps)

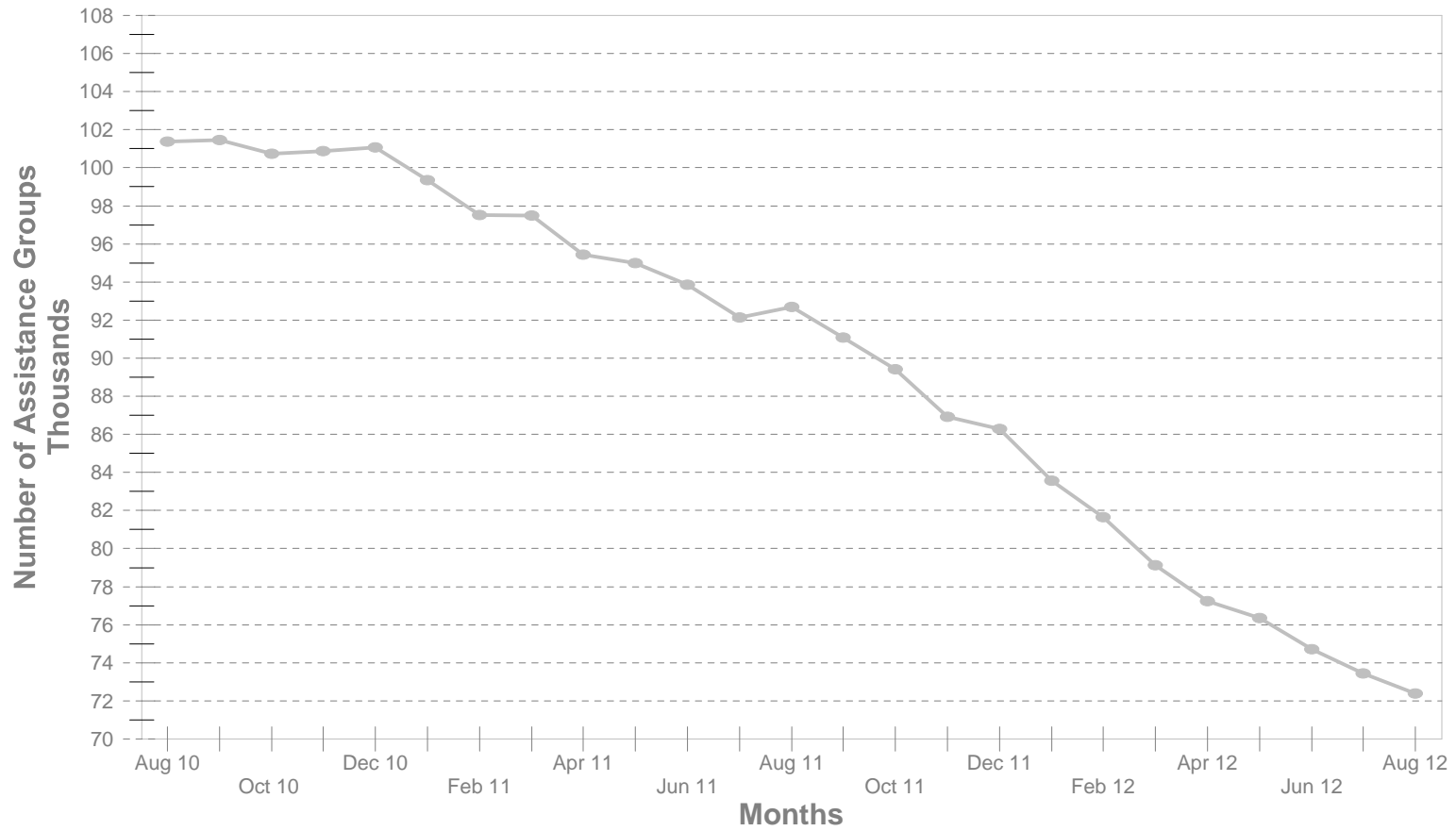
For the month of August 2012, there were 869,189 assistance groups; 1,787,417 recipients, and \$1,679,209 paid for FNS Benefits issuance. For August 2012, the average benefit issuance per person was \$138.28.

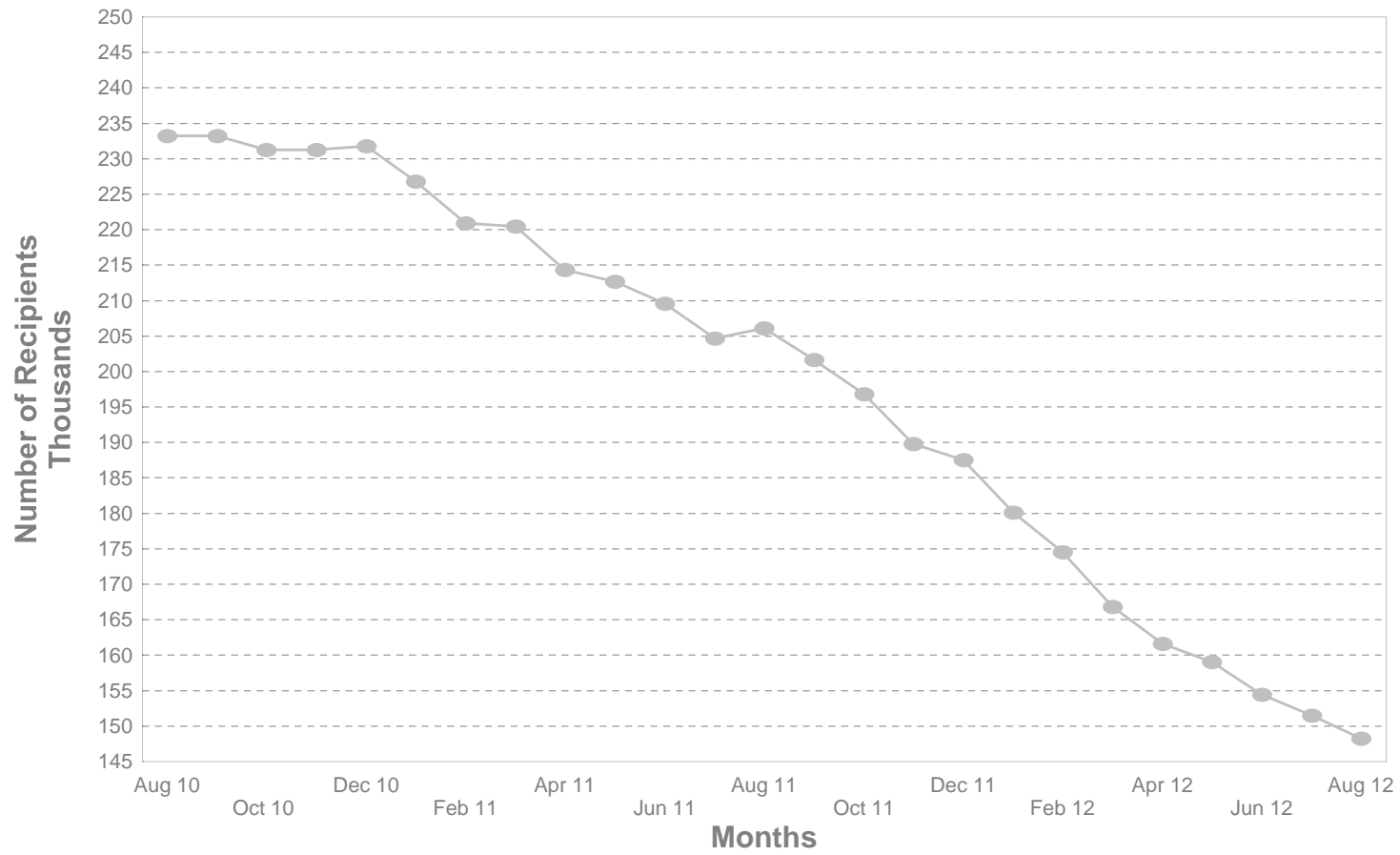

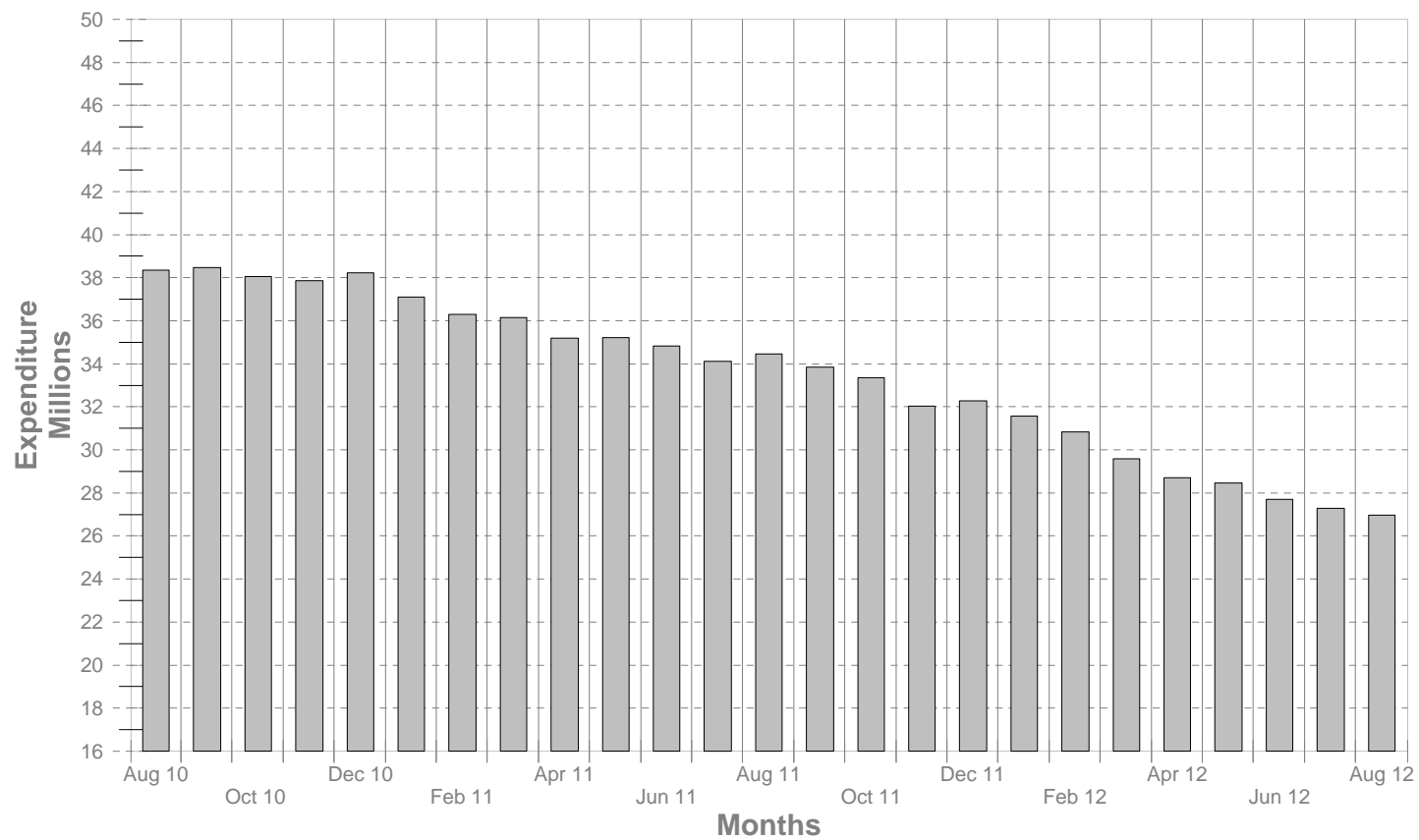
No. of OWF Combined Assistance Groups During The Last 25 months

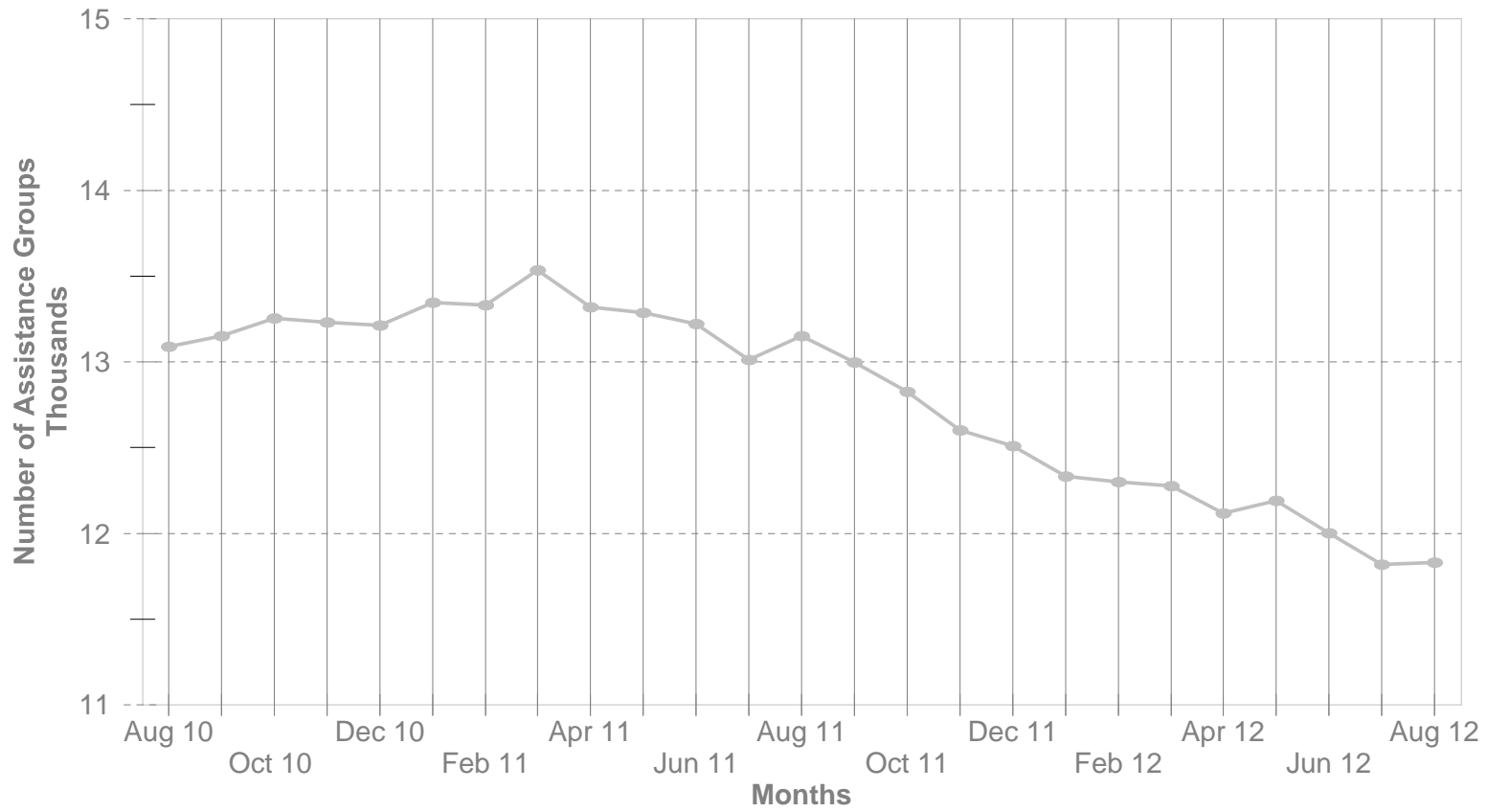

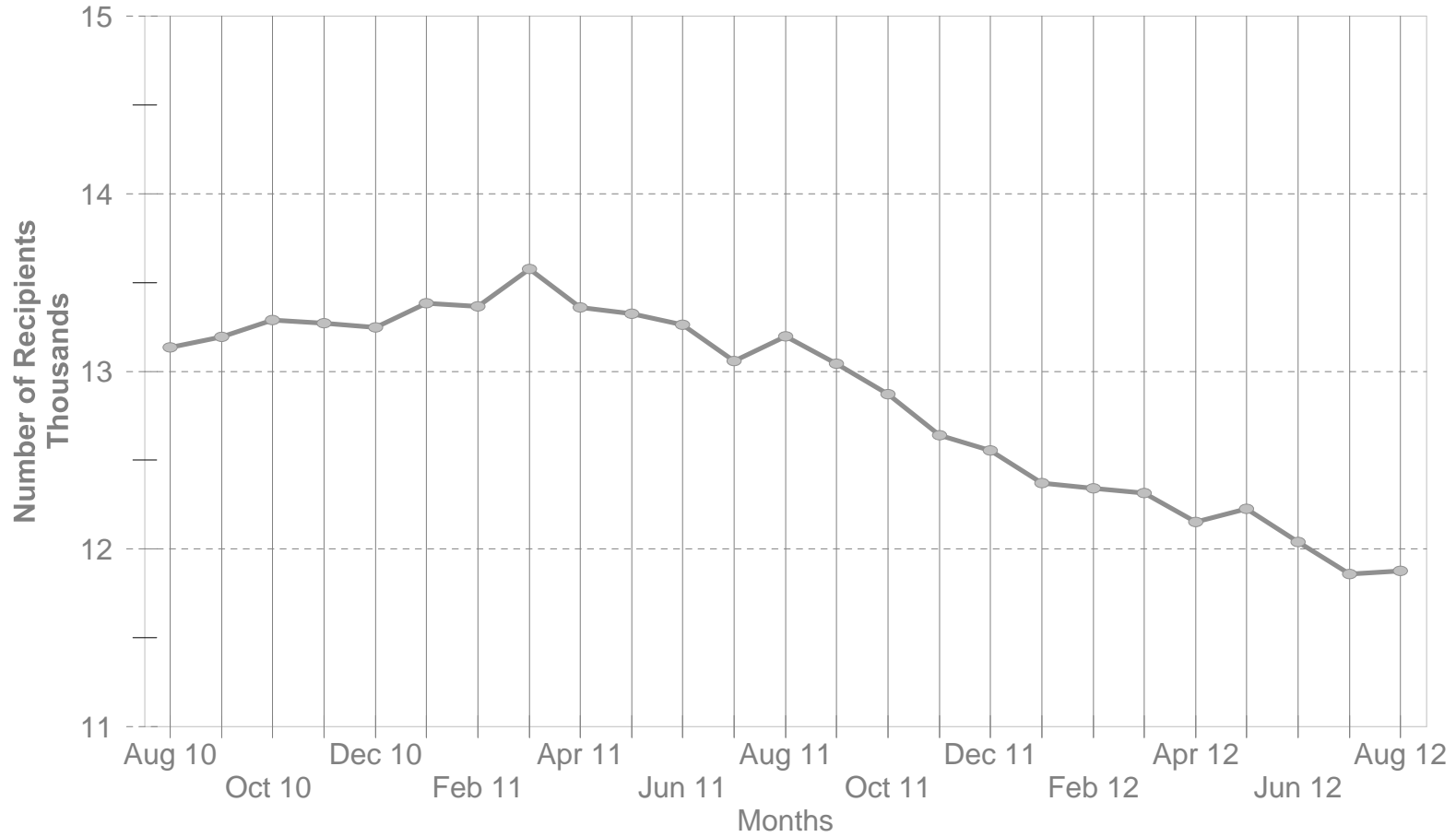

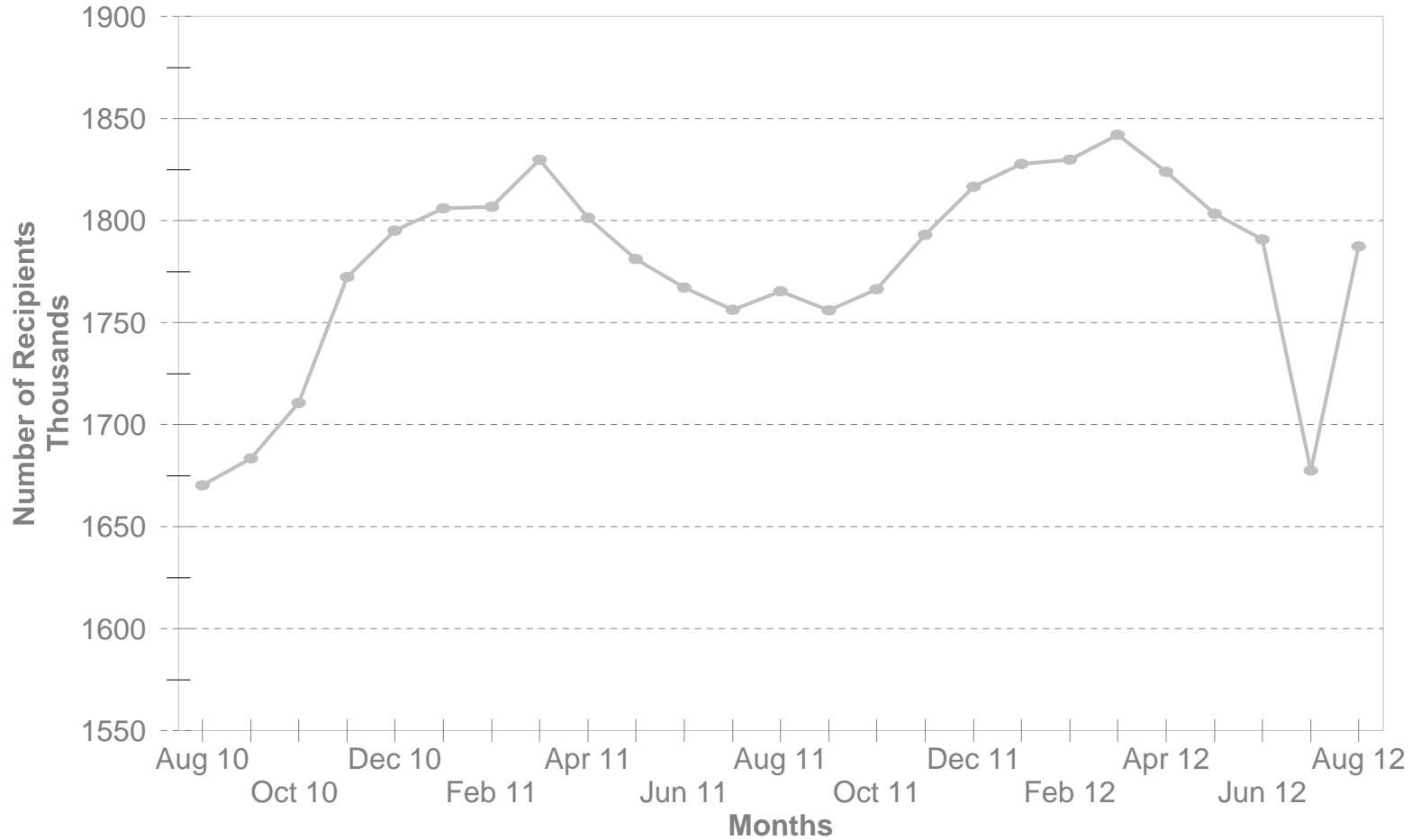
