- Session Title:** SACWIS Court/Legal Activities

- Reviewing a Court Process workflow.

 - Learning how critical components of the court area affect IV-E Foster Care Maintenance eligibility
 - Utilizing the court calendar.
 - Learning about court related notifications, ticklers and activity logs.
 - Exploring case scenarios pertaining to court/legal activities both as classroom step-by-step exercises and independently.
