The Northern Ohio Administrative District Council Regional Training Center for Bricklayers & Allied Craftworkers is accepting applications for its Apprentice Program. Applications are available at the nine (9) area Bricklayer Local Unions' Joint Apprenticeship Committee's office. Please call the NOADC-RTC at 330-463-5501 for the union hall or office nearest to your area.

The NOADC-RTC Program is a 4-year, 6000-hour on the job training program combined with 640 classroom and instructional training hours. The program is intent-to-hire. The applicant, once finding employment with a union contractor is placed on a 6-month trial period. During the 6 month trial period, a formal application is reviewed and the applicant receives an interview by the Joint Apprentice Committee. The committee is made up of three (3) members of Management and three (3) members of Labor.

Applicants accepted into the program are trained into many areas of the Bricklaying fields.

Classroom and Instructional training are during the months of September thru June. Registered apprentices attend classes one day every two weeks.

The current rate for a beginning apprentice depends on the county you work in. An apprentice receives a pay raise every 6 months and 750 working hours.
