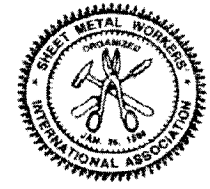

Sheet Metal Workers JATC Four Year Apprenticeship

Apprentices go to work 40 hours during the week doing sheet metal work.

- The JATC will place all apprentices at a sheet metal company.
- Most work is in and around the Columbus area.
- We do some jobs in surrounding communities.
 - Delaware, Newark, Circleville, Lancaster, etc.
- As an apprentice you will always work close enough to make it to school on time.
- Each apprentice will receive College credits with Columbus State

Apprentices go to school 75 nights each year (3 hours each night 6-9pm)

- 60 nights are shop and classroom, 15 nights are strictly welding.
- From September to April.
- 2 nights a week for half.
- 3 nights a week for half.

Assuming you work a 40 hour week (some companies expect you to work overtime).
