Want to Communicate? Go Ahead.™



Ohio Relay Service (ORS) is a free, service that provides full telephone accessibility to all people who are deaf, hard-of-hearing, deaf-blind, and speech disabled. This service allows text-telephone (TTY) users to communicate with regular telephone users through specially trained Communications Assistants (CAs).

Calls can be made to anywhere in the world, 24 hours a day, 365 days a year with no restrictions on the

number, length, or type of calls. All calls are strictly confidential and no records of any conversations are maintained.

Anyone wishing to use ORS simply dials the relay number to connect with a CA. The CA will dial the requested number and relay the conversation between the two callers. To make the conversation as natural as possible, CAs will type background noises and indicate voice inflections to the TTY user.
