- 1) Clark County has four contracted youth programs. On the out-of-school ratio of 30%, is the total youth counted from all programs together, or is each contract to have a ratio of 30% expenditures for out-of-school youth as opposed to in-school youth?**

The 30% out-of-school requirement is for all youth program expenditures for that year's federal allocation. You have access to spend a federal allocation over a two-year period. It is the percentage of youth funds spent possibly over that two-year period for the federal allocation.

- 2) Family's only income is Ohio Works First (OWF) and Social Security Insurance (SSI). This income is not included in six-month family income in calculations. However, when putting this information into SCOTI, should we use 0 as the family income because this type of income is not countable?**

Make the eligibility reason become a public assistance recipient. You will not be required to enter family six-month income for eligibility in SCOTI if the reason for eligibility is "public assistance recipient".
