# Drug Abuse

## Is Affecting Our Children

The numbers tell the story...

- 53% of the active Child Protective Services cases identify drugs as the primary concern.
- The remaining 47% identify drugs as the secondary concern.
- Protective Services currently has 175 children in custody.
- 141 (81%) of those children are in county custody as a result of drug activity.
- 69% of all children in county custody are under the age of 9.
- In 2010, the average monthly cost for children in the custody of the county was \$88,690.00.
