Every Child Succeeds Program - Every Child Succeeds (ECS) is dedicated to offering Greater Cincinnati at-risk, first-time parent and their children support to ensure an optimal start for children. ECS is voluntary prevention program that uses evidence-based strategies to promote parenting competence, healthy child development and family self sufficiency. ECS is based on a strong scientific foundation demonstrating that a nurturing and stimulating environment in the first three years of life promotes brain growth, cognitive development, social skills, and emotional and behavioral health. At the core of the approach is a caring, trusting relationship between a home visitor and a mom. Established when the mother is most receptive to information and guidance, this therapeutic relationship provides the impetus for mom to make positive behavioral change.

Healthy Moms and Babes - Healthy Moms and Babes, based in Hamilton County, Ohio, has two components that work interdependently to provide clients a comprehensive approach to meet the specific individual's needs. The mobile program is a community based outreach service consisting of two 34 foot vans which travel to 14 high risk neighborhoods in two States and three counties; 12 of the sites are in Hamilton County. The van staff consists of nurses, health educators, and social workers. Services include: pregnancy screening, information and referral to medical and social services, prenatal education including nutrition, fetal development, preterm labor, labor and delivery and post partum; infant growth and development education; parenting education; child health, adolescent health and women's health education. www.healthymomsandbabes.org
