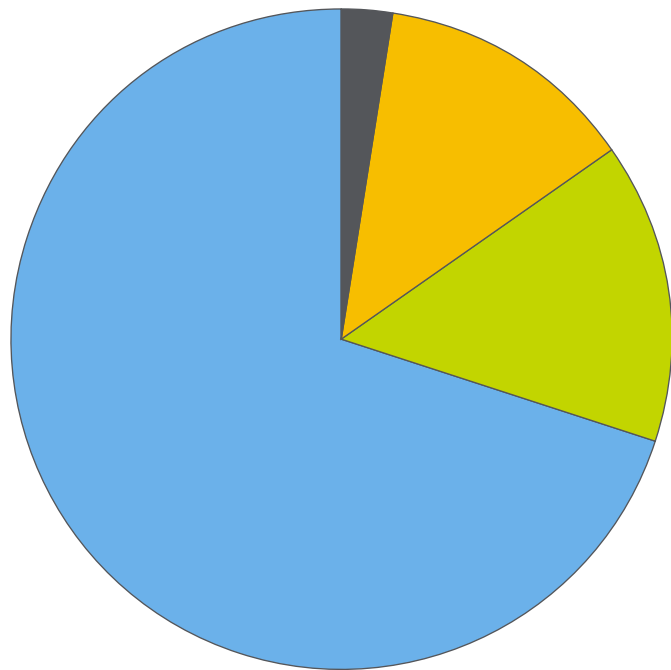

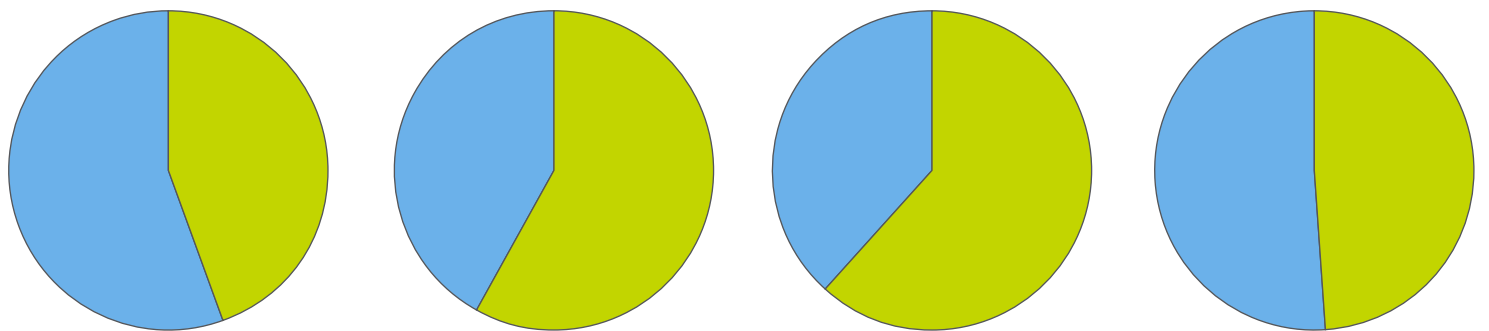
Unemployment Insurance Overpayments vs Pandemic Unemployment Assistance Overpayments

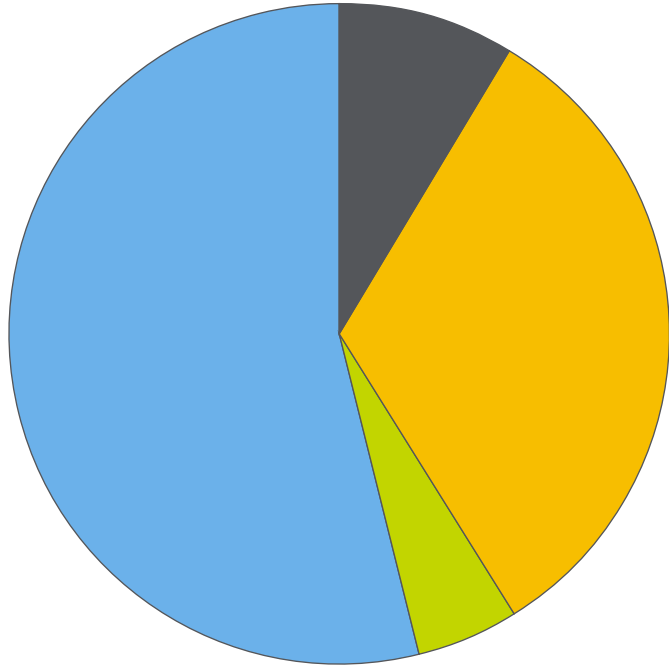
Key Terms

Unemployment Overpayments Recovery

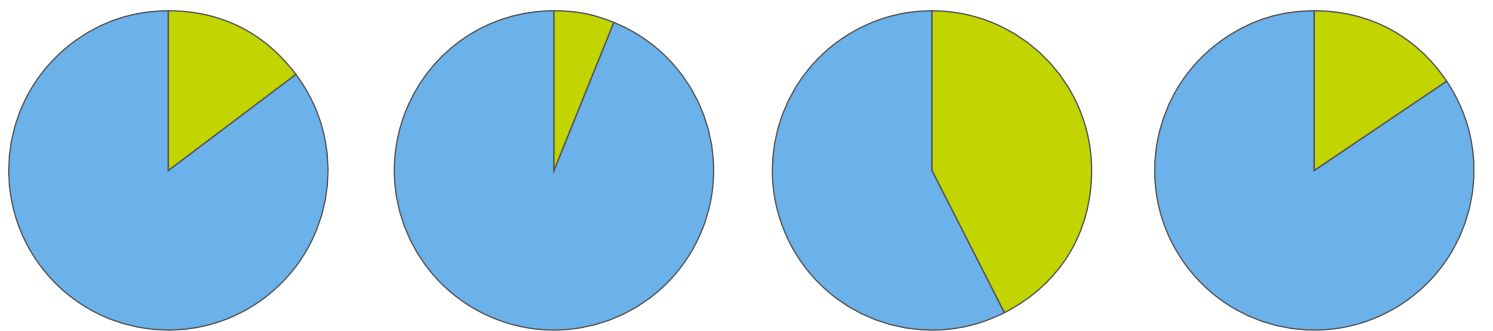
