Q1. The RFP has two submission deadlines. One is listed as March 10 at 3:00pm and one is listed as March 14 at 3:00 pm. Which is correct?

A1. This was an oversight on ODJFSs part. The correct submission date is March 14, at 3:00 pm.

Q2. The RFP appears to require that the curriculum include adult learning methodologies (page 7, Section IX.3.) and at the same time suggests that if ODJFS identifies possible greater economies in scheduling the contractor will have to adjust the training schedule (pg 6. D. Training Sessions). It is critical to understand that adult training methodologies require a smaller size training class for group activities and facilitation of discussion and further, forward the acquisition of knowledge and skills while large "taking head" trainings provide a greater economy of scale. How will this be reconciled?

A2. The reference to greater economies of scale is in reference to counties that may only provide a small number of participants. Therefore, it may be necessary to condense trainees from more than one county into one training. In addition, during the scheduling of the training, the ODJFS contract manager will work with the selected vendor to determine the most appropriate schedule and class size.
