If so, an In-Home Aide may be a solution to your child care needs.

The Ohio Department of Job and Family Services is conducting an In-Home Aide Pilot Program from April 1, 2021, through March 31, 2022. If you qualify, you can receive in-home care for your child if your child has special needs or if you need child care during evenings and/or weekends.

You must live in a participating county and be determined eligible for publicly funded child care. For more information visit: jfs.ohio.gov/form01309.

In-Home Aides are at least 18 years old and are certified by a county department of job and family services agency after completing background checks and other requirements. They care for your child in your home but do not live with you.
