

Child Care Center and Family Child Care Inspection Protocol

Rules 5101:2-12-03 and 5101:2-13-03 of the Ohio Administrative Code

<p>? How many inspections are required for child care centers in provisional license status?</p> <p>▶ At least two full inspections (one must be unannounced), or three if the center receives either of the following risk point totals:</p>	Non-compliance Level	Total Points
	Serious Risk	6 Points
	Moderate Risk	12 Points

<p>? How many inspections are required for child care centers in continuous license status?</p> <p>▶ At least one full unannounced inspection, or two if the center receives any of the following risk point totals at the annual inspection:</p>	Non-compliance Level	Total Points
	Serious Risk	6 Points
	Combined Moderate & Low Risk	9 Points
	Low Risk	14 Points

<p>? How many inspections are required for family child care programs in provisional <u>or</u> continuous license status?</p> <p>▶ At least two full inspections (one must be unannounced)</p> <p>➤ The county agency may add inspections based on accumulated risk points.</p>
