


Resources for Unemployed Ohioans

1. Online at **unemployment.ohio.gov**. This website is available 24/7.
2. By phone at 1-877-644-6562 or TTY 1-614-387-8408 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. weekdays and 9 a.m. to 1 p.m. on Saturday (excluding holidays).
