LEADERSHIP ADVISORY COMMITTEE AUGUST SESSION DESIGN DOCUMENT

Overall Purpose of This Work:

There are several votes needed to solidify recommendations for all QRTP subcommittees. This means the FFPSA Leadership Advisory committee will have a clear plan for the direction of QRTPs and can begin to move toward implementation planning. Based on the Act, states cannot begin to pull down funds for the prevention services until they have the QRTP standards in place. JFS leadership has decided to focus on completing the work of the QRTP subcommittee and do some additional planning for the prevention services.

Prevention Services is about designing a new way of providing services to eligible populations so there is a need to really focus simultaneously on design and strategy in addition of assessing the evidence-based provider landscape of the state. In this session, the goal is to finalize key QRTP Subcommittee recommendations and begin setting the stage for building Ohio's Prevention plan to ensure that every child and family flourishes.

Purpose of This Session:

- B. Discuss OhioKAN updates from the stakeholder group regarding the planning and design of Ohio's Kinship and Adoption Navigator program.
