**SUBJECT: FLOOR 2003/ADULT DISASTER ASSISTANCE: ADDITIONAL COUNTY ADDED**

We recently announced the availability of GRF funds for disaster assistance for elderly and disabled individuals who have been adversely affected by the recent severe weather conditions. Please refer to Office of Family Stability Letter (OFSL) #9, dated July 10, 2003.

It has come to our attention that the Governor has declared Shelby County to be in a state of emergency as a result of the recent weather emergencies. This brings the number of counties who are available to use GRF funds for disaster assistance for elderly and disabled individuals to six. The counties affected are Auglaize, Darke, Logan, Mercer, Shelby and Van Wert.

Office of Family Stability Letter (OFSL) #9 contains information regarding the amount of GRF funds available for each county and the process for reporting the amount spent for Flood 2003.

Note: This letter discusses requirements for accessing GRF funds for disaster assistance to elderly or disabled individuals. Please reference OWF/PRC Guidance Letter #17 for the requirements for disaster assistance for TANF-eligible families.
