Topic: **Federal Food Assistance Stimulus FFY 10**

The Federal Food Assistance Stimulus allocations for FFY 10 were recently allocated and made available for download into the QuIC+ system. Attached is a spreadsheet that includes the allocation amount for each county agency.

These funds may be used to reimburse the CDJFS for administrative costs associated with ensuring compliance with the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP), formerly known as the Food Stamp Program.

A Fiscal Administrative Policy Letter, which outlines the requirements, is currently in Clearance (#6736) @ <http://innerapp.odjfs.state.oh.us/clara/public/clearance.aspx>

To utilize the FFY10 Food Assistance Stimulus funding the CDJFS will perform a Post Allocated Adjustment (PAA) moving expenditures from the Federal Food Stamp and IM allocations to the Federal Food Assistance Stimulus FFY 10 grant. The Federal Food Assistance Stimulus allocation will be split; 50% will be used to reduce Federal Food Stamp expenditures and 50% will be used to reduce the IM expenditures. The CDJFS will report these adjusted amounts to the Federal Food Assistance Stimulus FFY 10 grant via the JFS 2827.

The CDJFS may use this funding for allowable expenditures incurred from October 1, 2009 through September 30, 2010. If a county does not utilize the funding by the end of FFY10, BCFTA will make an adjustment to expenditures during quarterly reconciliation.
