Topic: **Workforce Investment Act (WIA) – Change to Catalogue of Federal Domestic Assistance (CFDA) Number 17.260 – Dislocated Worker Funding**

In an effort to provide better transparency and accountability for Federal funds, the Employment and Training Administration (ETA) has split the CFDA number associated with WIA Dislocated Worker funds into new CFDA numbers. The new CFDA numbers apply for PY (2010), FY (2011) and subsequent program/federal years.

Therefore, effective immediately, CFDA number 17.260 WIA Dislocated Workers will **no longer** be used on any new grants associated with the Dislocated Worker allocation. For all grants issued from the Dislocated Worker Appropriation **after** June 30, 2010, the following numbers will be used:

CFDA# 17.277 - WIA National Emergency Grants
CFDA# 17.278 - WIA Dislocated Worker Formula Grants

Grants awarded **prior** to July 1, 2010, will continue to use CFDA #17.260 during the life of their funds. Please refer to ETA's *Training Employment Guidance Letter (TEGL) 10-10*.

There may be changes to future National Emergency Grants and other special Dislocated Worker funding sent to the local areas. Local areas will be notified of the correct CFDA for those allocations at the time new funding is issued.

BCFTA will update CFIS/QuIC+ and details regarding the CFDA report from QuIC+ will be communicated by Maximus. ODJFS will also amend OAC rules 5101:9-31-02 and 5101:9-6-53 to reflect this change.
